

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\otimes}$ Colorama ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ O'Go $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $6.4 \mathrm{oz} / 180 \mathrm{~g} ; 228 \mathrm{yds} / 208 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Lippy (68004) 10'Go
Contrast B Baja (68013)
1 O'Go


Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle



## ABBREVIATIONS

| Approx $=$ | Cont = Continue(ity) | Rep = Repeat |

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" [23 cm] wide x 80" [ 203 cm ] long, excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

10 sts and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Start crocheting!
- Pull tie to remove.
- Use colors as they appear from each O'Go, using Contrast A O'Go for 2 rows and Contrast B O'Go for 2 rows to create random Stripe Pat as shown.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of first color. Yoh (Yarn over hook) with new color, draw through loops and proceed with new color.
- Carry color not in use up side of work.
- Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.


## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

Stripe Pattern (Pat)
With A, work 2 rows.
With B, work 2 rows.
These 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

SCARF (worked lengthwise)
With A, chain (ch) 202.
1 st row: 1 half double crochet (hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 200 hdc .
2nd row: Ch 2. Working in back loops only, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Join B.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Continue (Cont) in Stripe Pat, repeat (rep) 2 nd row until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 9" [23 cm], ending with 2 rows of $B$.
Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut strands of Contrast B leftover shades 16 " [ 40.5 cm ] long. Taking 3 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe across ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
