



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Hdc** = Half double

crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" [23 cm] wide x 80" [203 cm] long, excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

10 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Start crocheting!
- Pull tie to remove.
- Use colors as they appear from each O'Go, using Contrast A O'Go for 2 rows and Contrast B O'Go for 2 rows to create random Stripe Pat as shown.
- To join new color, work to last loops on hook of first color. Yoh (Yarn over hook) with new color, draw through loops and proceed with new color.
- Carry color not in use up side of work.
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as hdc.

## MATERIALS

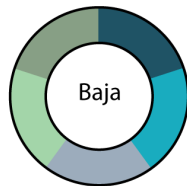
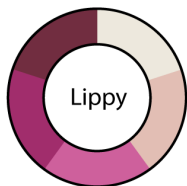
Caron® Colorama™ O'Go™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 228 yds/208 m)

**Contrast A** Lippy (68004)

**1 O'Go**

**Contrast B** Baja (68013)

**1 O'Go**



Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Yarn needle

### Stripe Pattern (Pat)

With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

### SCARF (worked lengthwise)

With A, chain (ch) 202.

**1st row:** 1 half double crochet (hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 200 hdc.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Working in back loops only, 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Join B.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Continue (Cont) in Stripe Pat, repeat (rep) 2nd row until work from beginning (beg) measures approx 9" [23 cm], ending with 2 rows of B. Fasten off.

**Fringe:** Cut strands of Contrast B leftover shades 16" [40.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe across ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
