

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Colorama ${ }^{\text {Tm }} \mathbf{O}^{\prime} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {TM }}$ ( $6.4 \mathrm{oz} / 180 \mathrm{~g} ; 228 \mathrm{yds} / 208 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Baja (68013)
1 O'Go
Salt and Pep (68001) 10'Go


Size U.S. J/10 [6 mm] crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. 6 " $[15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] piece of cardboard for tassels. Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 70" [20.5 x 178 cm ] excluding tassels.

## GAUGE

10 hhdc and 8 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Start crocheting!

- Designate each color A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J as indicated in Materials.
- Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as st.


## Stripe Pat

With G, work 6 rows. With D, work 4 rows. With J, work 2 rows. With I, work 6 rows. With E, work 6 rows. With B, Work 4 rows. With H, work 2 rows. With C, work 6 rows. With J, work 2 rows. With F, work 4 rows. With A, work 8 rows. With J, work 2 rows. With D, work 2 rows. With E, work 8 rows. With G, work 2 rows. With H, work 4 rows. With I, work 2 rows. With F, work 6 rows. With D, work 4 rows. With H, work 4 rows. With A, work 6 rows. With I, work 4 rows. With J, work 2 rows. With C, work 6 rows. With F, work 2 rows. With H, work 4 rows.

With D, work 2 rows. With J, work 2 rows. With G, work 6 rows. With I, work 2 rows. With B, work 10 rows. With C, work 2 rows. With F, work 2 rows. With J, work 4 rows. With D, work 2 rows.
These 140 rows complete Stripe Pat.

## SCARF

With G, ch 22.
1st row: (RS). 1 hhdc in 3 rd ch from hook. 1 hhdc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 20 hhdc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 hhdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are now complete.
Rep 2nd row until all 140 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Fasten off.

## Edging

1st row: (RS). Join F with sl st to any corner of Scarf. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly down long edge of Scarf. Fasten off.

Rep for opposite edge of Scarf.

## Tassel (make 4)

With 1 strand of each shade held tog (10 shades total), wrap yarn around $6 "[15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] piece of cardboard 3 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap 1 strand of $C 6$ times around Tassel $11 / 2$ " $[4 \mathrm{~cm}]$ from tied end. Fasten securely. Sew 1 Tassel to each corner of Scarf.


Stripe Pattern

Each rectangle $=2$ rows
