 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont = Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet
PM = Place marker
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Trfp = (Yoh) twice and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 30" [76 cm] deep x 64" [162.5 cm] long

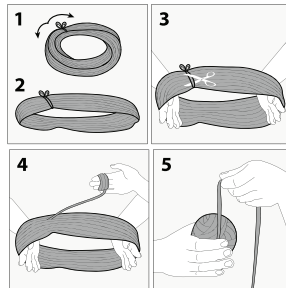
GAUGE

11 sc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Before working with Caron x Pantone multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone # (see ball band)
- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results

Note: Move marker along work. Ch 4 at beg of row counts as st.

VERSION 1 - Stripe Pats A and B Version 1 - Stripe Pat A

With A, crochet until 3 links are used, ending on a WS row.

MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz /100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Bright Orchid (01037)	5	6	braids

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

A - 19-0000	B - 15-3214	C - 14-3812	D - 14-4812	E - 14-0452
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With B, crochet until 3 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With C, crochet until 3 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With D, crochet until 5 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With E, crochet until 5 links are used, ending on a WS row.

Stripe Pat A is complete.

Version 1 - Stripe Pat B

With A, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With B, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With C, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

Stripe Pat B is complete.

VERSION 2 - Stripe Pats A and B

Version 2 - Stripe Pat A

**With E, crochet until 1½ links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

With D, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

With C, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows. ***

With B, crochet until 3 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

Rep from ** to *** once.

With B, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

Stripe Pat A is complete.

Version 2 - Stripe Pat B

With A, crochet 2 rows.

With E, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

With D, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

With C, crochet until 2 links are used, ending on a WS row.

With A, crochet 2 rows.

Stripe Pat B is complete.

VERSION 1 AND VERSION 2

Proceed in Stripe Pat A for your chosen Version as follows:

Ch 4.

1st row: (RS). 2 dc in 4th ch from hook. 3 dc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in last dc. Turn. 2 sts.

3rd row: Ch 4. 1 dc in first sc. 1 trfp around next dc 2 rows below. PM on last st. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn. 6 sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each of first 2 sts. 1 sc in next dc. Skip marked st. 2 sc in each of last 2 sts. Turn. 9 sts.

5th row: Ch 4. 1 dc in first sc. 1 dc in next sc. 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn. 9 sts.

6th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each of first 2 sts. 1 sc in each dc to marked st. PM on last st. Skip marked st. 1 sc in next dc. 2 sc in each of last 2 sts. Turn. 12 sts.

7th row: Ch 4. 1 dc in first sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 sc. 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sc. 1 dc in each sc to last sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn. 12 sts.

8th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each of first 2 sts. 1 sc in each dc to marked st. PM on last st. Skip marked st. 1 sc in each dc to last 2 sts. 2 sc in each of last 2 sts. Turn. 15 sts.

9th row: Ch 4. 1 dc in first sc. 1 dc in each sc to 2 sc before marked st. 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sc. 1 dc in each sc to last sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn. 15 sts.

First 9 rows of Stripe Pat A are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, rep 8th and 9th rows, noting increases, until Stripe Pat A is complete, ending on a WS row.

Proceed in Stripe Pat B for your chosen Version as follows:

1st row: (RS). Sl st in first st. 1 sc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each sc to 2 sc before marked st. 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sc. 1 dc in each sc to last sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each of first 2 sts. 1 sc in each dc to marked st. PM on last st. Skip marked st. 1 sc in each dc to last sc. 1 sl st in next sc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

3rd row: Skip first sl st. Sl st in next st. 1 sc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. 1 dc in each sc to 2 sc before marked st. 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sc. 1 dc in each sc to last sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat B, rep last 2 rows, until row **"Next row: (RS). Skip first sl st. Sl st in next st. (At this point there will be 2 sts before marked st). 1 trfp around trfp 2 rows below. PM on last st. Skip next 4 sts. 1 dc in each sc to last sc. (2 dc. 1 tr) in last sc. Turn."** has been completed. Fasten off.
