

## **CARON**<sup>®</sup> RAINY DAY CROCHET SHAWL



#### MATERIALS

Caron<sup>®</sup> Cotton Ripple Cakes<sup>™</sup> (8.4 oz/240 g; 491 yds/449 m)

Summer Rain (37017)

2 balls

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

### ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
<b>Beg</b> = Beginning
<b>Ch</b> = Chain(s)
<b>Dc</b> = Double crochet
<b>Picot</b> = Ch 3. Sl st in 3rd ch from
hook
<b>Rep</b> = Repeat

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 35" [89 cm] deep x 56" [142 cm] long.

### **GAUGE**

16 sc and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm].

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Notes:

- Ch 4 at beg of rows counts as tr.
- Move marker to new center ch-sp as you work each row.

Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring. See diagram on page 2.

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 3 (counts as dc). [1 dc. (Ch 3. 2 dc) 3 times] in ring. Turn. RS = Right side Sc = Single crochet Sl st = Slip stitch Sp(s) = Space(s) St(s) = Stitch(es) Tr = Treble crochet WS = Wrong side

2nd row: Ch 4. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 2 dc. (3 dc. Ch 4. 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp. Place marker on center ch-4 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 2 dc. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. 1 dc in next dc. 1 tr in top of ch 3. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 4. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 4. 3 dc) in next center ch-4 sp. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 2. 1 dc in next dc. 1 tr in top of ch 4. Turn. 4th row: Ch 4. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc.\* (3 dc. Ch 4. 3 dc) in next center ch-4 sp.

#### CARON **RAINY DAY CROCHET SHAWL**

#### **CAC0126-030292M** | December 15, 2020

Rep from \* to \* to last ch-2 sp. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 2. 1 dc in next dc. 1 tr in top of ch 4. Turn. **5th row:** Ch 4. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp.\* Rep from \* to \* to last 3 dc before center ch-4 sp. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. (3 dc. Ch 4. 3 dc) in next center ch-4 sp. Rep from \* to \* to last 3 dc. Ch 2. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 2. 1 dc in next dc. 1 tr in top of ch 4. Turn.

6th row: Ch 4. 1 dc in next dc. Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. Skip next dc. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) 3 times. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc.\* (3 dc. Ch 4. 3 dc) in next center ch-4 sp. Rep from \* to \* to last ch-2 sp. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 2. 1 dc in next dc. 1 tr in top of ch 4. Turn.

Rep 5th and 6th rows until Shawl along center line measures approx 35" [89 cm], ending on 5th row.

Edging: 1st row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first tr. 1 sc in each st and ch to center ch-4 sp. 7 sc in center ch-4 sp. 1 sc in each st and ch to end of row. Turn. 2nd row: (Picot row). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. \*Picot. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from \*, ending with Picot. 1 sc in last sc. Fasten off.
