



MATERIALS

Caron® Cotton Cakes™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 530 yds/485 m)
Elderberry Rose (70023) **3 cakes**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =
Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet

Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 23½" x 63½" [59.5 x 161.5 cm]

GAUGE

14 sc and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Shawl is worked lengthwise.
- To maintain consistent color changes, join new cake to match last color change of previous cake. This will help to ensure stripe repeat will match as closely as possible.
- Ch-1 sp counts as st.
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

SHAWL

Ch 224 (multiple of 2 ch + 4).

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 223 sc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 dc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 2. 1 dc in first sc. *1 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 dc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th and 7th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows.

8th to 12th rows: Ch 2. 1 dc in first st. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn.

13th row: As 3rd row.

Rep 2nd to 13th rows 4 times more. Fasten off.
