



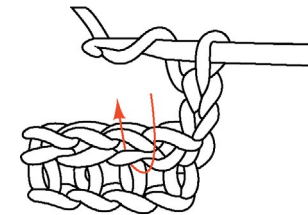
CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =
Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Inc = Increase(ing)
Hdc = Half double
crochet

Hdchb = Work 1
hdc into horizontal
bar created below
stitch in previous row
(bar is below loops
normally worked on
WS – see diagram).

Inc = Increase(ing)
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side



MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama Halo™ O'Go™ (8 oz/227 g; 481 yds/440 m)
Orchid Frost (28001) **3 O'Gos**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 80" [203 cm] at longest
point x 25" [63.5 cm] at widest
point, excluding fringe.

GAUGE

10 Hdchb and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as hdc.
- Shawl is worked from bottom up.

Ch 102.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 100 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 2 hdchb in first hdc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last hdc. 2 hdchb in last hdc. Turn. 102 sts. Rep last row, inc 1 st at each end of every row, until there are 200 hdc. Fasten off at end of last row.

FINISHING

Cut lengths of yarn 30" [76 cm] long. Taking 3 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe evenly across 2 shorter sides of Shawl. Trim fringe evenly.
