Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\oplus}$ ( 6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)
Contrast A Soft Green (39739) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{7 7} \mathbf{y d s} / \mathbf{7 0} \mathbf{~ m}$
Contrast B Robin's Egg (39780) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{8 8}$ yds/80 m
Contrast C Soft Pink (39719) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or $\mathbf{1 1 0} \mathbf{~ y d s / 1 0 0 ~ m}$
Contrast D Strawberry (COL0015)
Contrast E Persimmon (39754)
1 ball or $135 \mathrm{yds} / 120 \mathrm{~m}$

Size U.S. K/10 $1 / 2$ ( 6.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\circledR}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ stitch markers. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $18 \times 60$ " $[45.5 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

12 dc and $61 / 2$ rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Right Side

With A, ch 42.
1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4 th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each ch to last ch. [(1 dc. Ch 1) 4 times. 1 dc all in last ch. Working across opposite side of foundation ch, 1 dc in each ch to last 6 ch . Turn. Leave rem 6 ch unworked.

RS = Right side
$\mathbf{S I} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
Sp = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch (es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side
2nd row: (WS). Ch 3.1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. [(1 dc. Ch 1) twice. 1 dc$]$ in next dc - corner made. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp .1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch- 1 sp .1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: (RS). Ch 3.1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp .1 dc in each of next 5 dc .1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch- 1 sp .1 dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off. Do not turn.

With RS facing, join B with sl st to first dc of 3rd row.
4th row: (RS). With B, ch 8.1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each of next 4 ch . Working in back loops only, 1 dc in next dc (same st as joining sl st). 1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first $\mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sp}$. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp .1 dc in each dc to last 6 dc . Turn. Leave rem 6 dc unworked.
5th row: (WS). Ch 3. Working in both loops, 1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next ch- 1 sp . Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.
6th row: (RS). As 5th row.
Fasten off.

With RS facing, join C with sl st to first dc of 6th row.
7th to 9th rows: With C, as 4th to 6th rows.

With RS facing, join D with sl st to first dc of 9th row.
10th to 12th rows: With D, as 4th to 6th rows.

With RS facing, join E with sl st to first dc of 12th row.
13th to 15th rows: With E, as 4th to 6th rows.
Fasten off.

## Left Side

Work as given for Right Side, noting RS and WS will be reversed, and working 4th, 7th, 10th and 13th rows in front loops only.

## FINISHING

Sew Right and Left Sides tog between corners.
