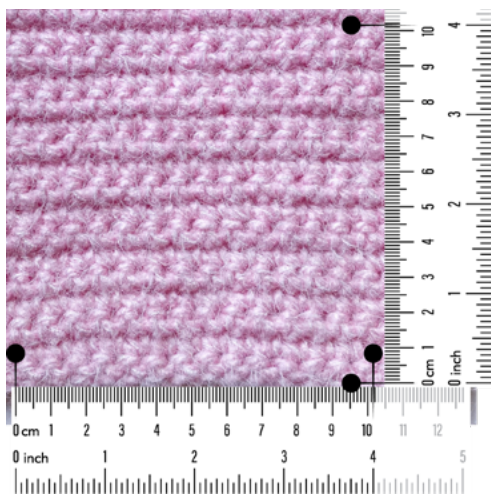
MAKE THIS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED



GAUGE

14 **single crochet** (sc) and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm].



YARN

- **Caron® Colorama Halo™ Perfect Phasing™** (8 oz/227 g; 481 yds/440 m)

COLORS

Quantity

- **Orchid Frost (76001)**
4 balls or 1924 yds/1760 m

TOOLS

- Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® steel yarn needle.
- Tape measure.



ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =	Sc = Single crochet
Approximately	Scbl = Single crochet
Beg = Begin(ning)	in back loop only
Ch = Chain(s)	Tog = Together
Rep = Repeat	Yoh = Yarn over
RS = Right side	hook

INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

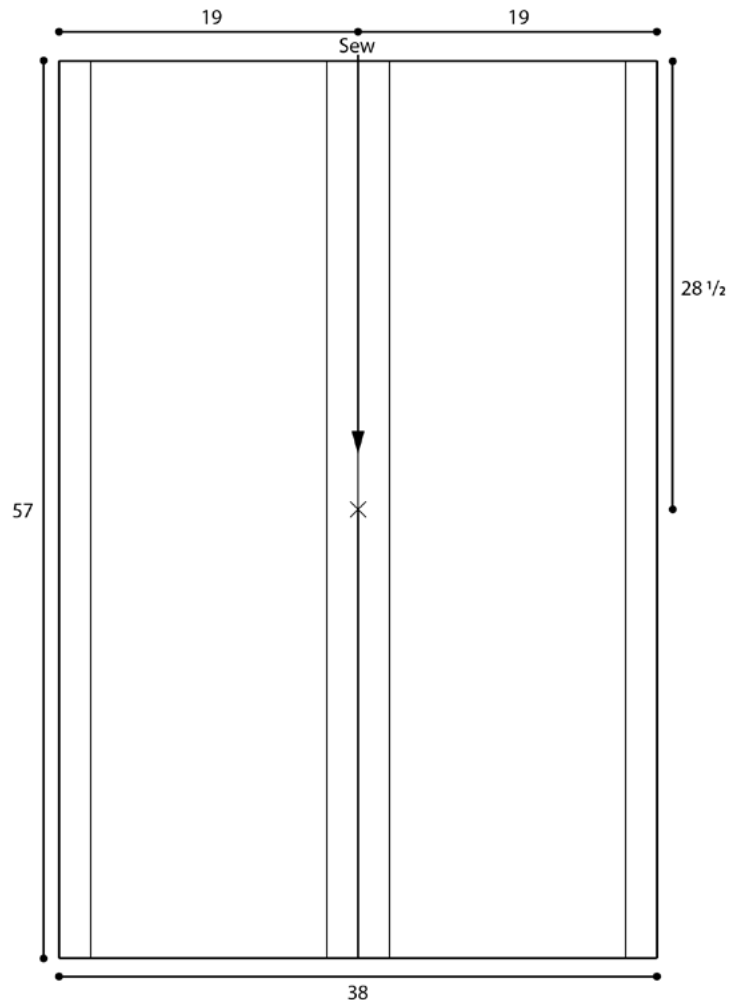
NOTES

- Shawl is worked in 2 Panels from bottom front edge to bottom back edge and seamed together (tog) in Finishing.
- Use first 2 balls as a set for first Panel and second 2 balls as a set for second Panel.
- Yarn is designed with gradual change from one color (A) to contrast Color (B). Determine for yourself what will be Color A and Color B.
- To maintain ombre effect join second ball, when necessary, from opposite end so shades match (lightest end to lightest end in this design) resulting in a fade from Color A to Color B, and back again across the Panel.

MEASUREMENT

One size fits all: Approximately (Approx) 38" [96.5 cm] wide x 28½" [72.5 cm] long from shoulder.

Panel measurements: Approx 19" [48.5 cm] wide x 57" [145 cm] long.



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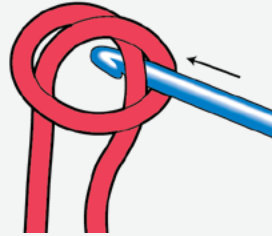
SHAWL

Panel 1

Make a **slip knot** and place on hook.

Slip Knot

Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.



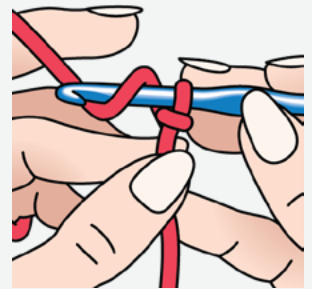
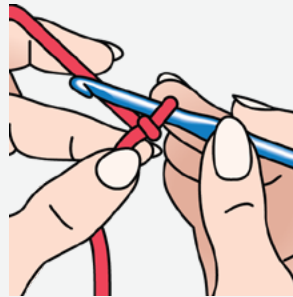
Then draw through to make slip knot.



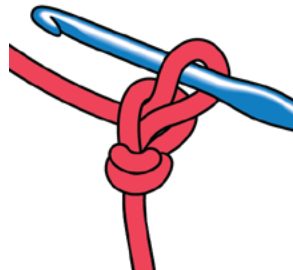
With first ball of yarn, **chain** (ch) 67.

Chain

Yarn over hook (Yoh),



draw yarn through loop on hook - Chain made.

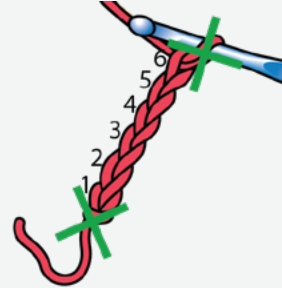


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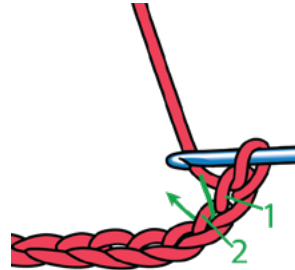
Continue until 67 chains made.



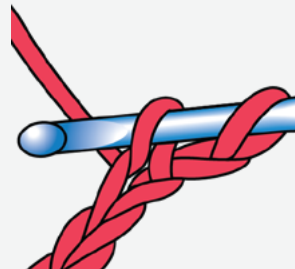
1st row: [Right side (RS)]. 1 **single crochet** (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 66 single crochet (sc).

Single Crochet

Insert hook in second chain from hook.

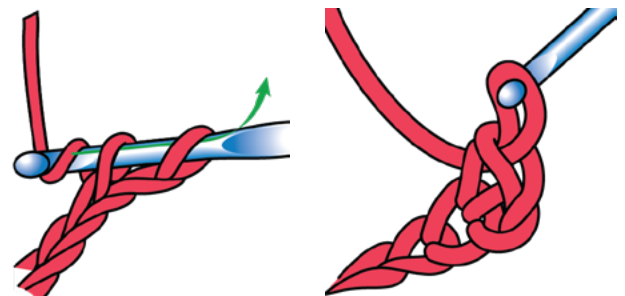


Yarn over hook (Yoh). Draw yarn through chain. Two loops now on hook.



Yoh. Draw yarn through both loops on hook - 1 single crochet (1 sc) made.

Continue until 66 single crochet are made working 1 single crochet into each chain to end of chain.



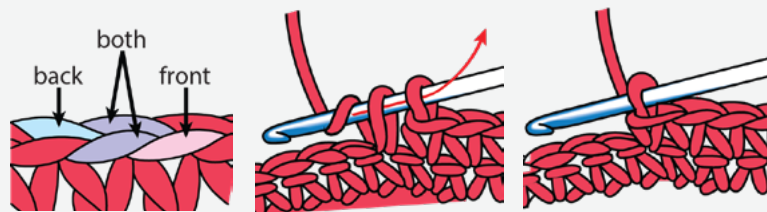
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2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in back loop only (scbl) in each of first 7 sc. 1 sc in each sc to last 7 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 7 sc. Turn.



Repeat (Rep) 2nd row until work from beginning (beg) measures 57" [145 cm]. Lay work on a flat surface to measure. **Fasten off.**

Panel 2

Work as given for Panel 1, using second set of balls.

Finishing

With last rows aligned and RS facing, sew Panels together (tog) along center line to half-way 28½" [72.5 cm] (as shown in diagram on page 3), using Flat Seam making sure to hide seam.
