



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Tr3tog = [(Yoh) twice and draw up a loop. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice] 3 times in indicated st. Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook. Ch 1 to close stitch - Tr3tog made.

Tr6tog = [(Yoh) twice and draw up a loop in next tr. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice] 3 times. Skip next (ch 1, sc, ch 1). [(Yoh) twice and draw up a loop in next tr. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice] 3 times. Yoh and draw through all 7 loops on hook. Ch 1 to close stitch - Tr6tog made

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 21" x 78" [53.5 x 198 cm].

GAUGES

11.5 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].
2 pat reps = 6" [15 cm].

MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama Halo™ Perfect Phasing™ (8 oz/227 g; 481 yds/440 m)

Tin and Tan (76031)

3 balls or 1155 yds/1050 m

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 2 Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- First section of Scarf works with first ball, beg with darker shade indicated and letting colors change as you go.
- Second section of Scarf works with second ball, beg with lighter shade indicated and letting colors change as you go.
- Third section of Scarf works with first ball, beg with darker shade indicated and letting colors change as you go.
- Ch 4 at beg of row counts as tr.

Scallop edge

See diagram on page 3.

Foundation row: (RS). Beg with darker shade of first ball, ch 4. Tr3tog in 4th ch from hook. *Ch 4. Tr3tog in top of previous cluster. Rep from * 16 times more. Turn. 18 Tr Clusters.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (WS). Ch 4. 3 tr in top of last Tr3tog. *Ch 1. 1 sc in top of next Tr3tog. Ch 1. (3 tr. Ch 3. 3 tr) in top of next cluster. Rep from * to last Tr3tog. Ch 1. 1 sc in top of next Tr3tog. Ch 1. Skip last Tr3tog. 4 tr in first ch of first Tr3tog. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in top of first tr. *Ch 5. Tr6tog over next 6 tr. Ch 5. 1 sc in ch-3 sp. Rep from * ending with 1 sc in top of turning ch 4. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-5 sp. (3 tr. Ch 3. 3 tr) in top of next tr6tog. Ch 1. Skip next ch-5. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 4. Skip next sc. Tr3tog over next 3 tr. *Ch 5. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 5. Tr6tog over next 6 tr. Rep from * to last (ch-3, 3 tr, ch 1, sc). Ch 5. 1 sc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 5. Tr3tog over next 3 tr. 1 tr in last sc. Turn.

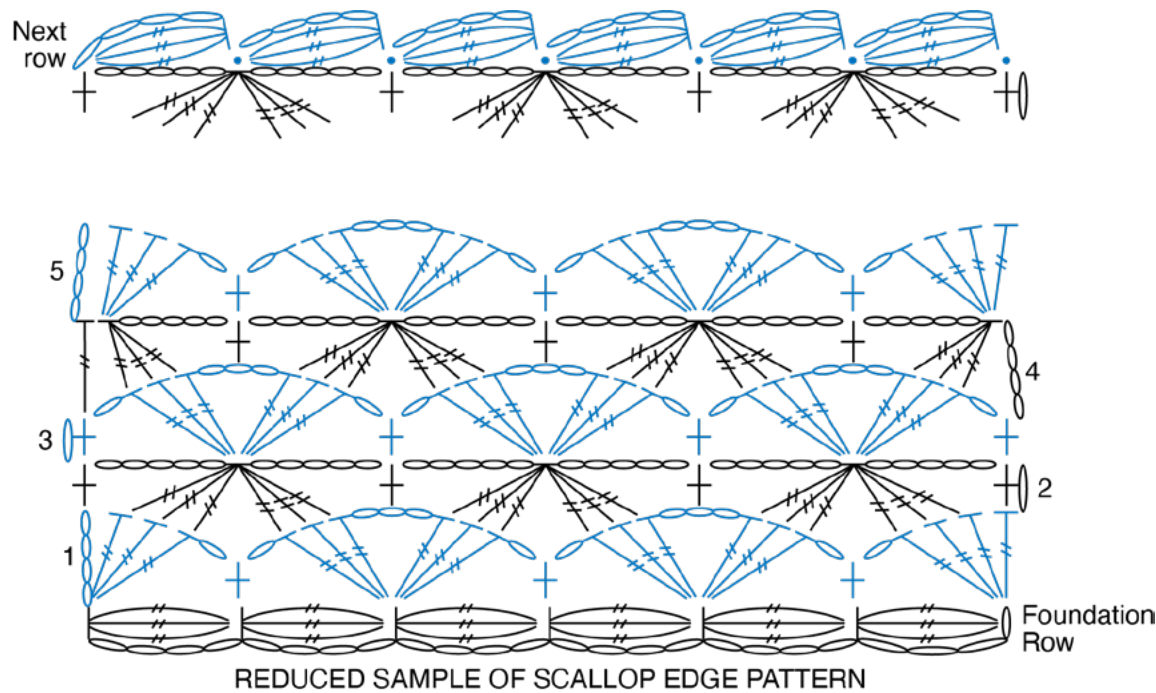
5th row: Ch 4. 3 tr in top of last Tr3tog. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-5 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next ch-5 sp. (3 tr. Ch 3. 3 tr) in top of next cluster. Rep from * to last Tr3tog. Skip last Tr3tog. 4 tr in top of turning ch 4. Turn. Rep 2nd to 5th rows for pat, until entire ball is used, ending with lighter color.

Join lighter end of 2nd ball and cont in pat, until entire ball is used, ending with darker color. Join darker end of 3rd ball and cont in pat, until approx 45 yds [42 m] of yarn left for Scallop Edging, ending on a 2nd or 4th row.









Scallop Edging

Next row: Ch 4. Tr3tog in top of last sc. *Skip next ch-5 sp. Sl st to top of next st. Ch 4. Tr3tog in same sp as sl st. Rep from * to end of row, ending with sl st to last sc. Fasten off. 16 Tr Clusters.





STITCH KEY

-  = chain (ch)
-  = slip stitch (sl st)
-  = single crochet (sc)
-  = treble crochet (tr)
-  = Cluster
-  or  = treble crochet 3 together (tr3tog)
-  = treble crochet 6 together (tr6tog)
