ABBREVIATIONS

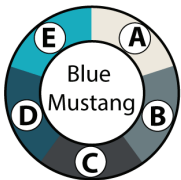
Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont = Continuity

Sc = Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama™ O'Go™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 228 yds/208 m)

Sizes **XS/S** **M** **L** **XL** **2/3XL** **4/5XL**
 Blue Mustang (68015) **4** **4** **5** **6** **7** **7** O'Gos



Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Yarn needle.

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]
M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]
L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]
XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]
2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]
4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust

XS/S 44" [112 cm]
M 48" [122 cm]
L 52" [132 cm]
XL 56" [142 cm]
2/3XL 63" [160 cm]
4/5XL 69" [175.5 cm]

GAUGE

12 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Sc/Ch-1 Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section (Contrast A, B, C, D, E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D, E.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.

BACK

With D, ch **32 (38-40-44-48-52). With E, ch **32** (38-40-44-48-52). **64** (76-80-88-96-104) ch total.

1st row: (RS). With E, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch) **15** (18-19-22-23-25) times, joining D in last sc. With D, *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from * to end of ch. Turn. **63** (75-79-87-95-103) sts.

2nd row: With D, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. (1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc) **15** (18-19-22-23-25) times. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Join E. With E, *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: With E, ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) **15** (18-19-22-23-25) times, joining D in last sc. With D, *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. Rep last 2 rows for Sc/Ch-1 pat until piece measures **11** (11-11-12-12-12)" [**28** (28-28-30.5-30.5-30.5) cm], ending on a 2nd row. Fasten off.

Shape square armholes:

1st row: (RS). Skip first **4** (4-6-6-8-8) sts. Join B with sl st to next sc. Ch 1. Pat across next **27** (33-33-37-39-43) sts, joining A in last st. With A, pat across next **28** (34-34-38-40-44) sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **55** (67-67-75-79-87) sts.**

Cont even in pat, changing colors at center of row as before, until Armholes measure **8** (9-9-10-10-11)" [**20.5** (23-23-25.5-25.5-28) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Cont even in pat, changing colors at center of row as before, until work from beg measures 8 rows less than Back, ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: Left side: 1st row:

(RS). Ch 1. Pat across **24** (28-28-32-34-36) sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog (over first sc and ch-1 sp). Pat to end of row. Turn. **23** (27-27-31-33-35) sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog (over next ch-1 sp and st). Turn. **22** (26-26-30-32-34) sts.

4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog (over first st and ch-1 sp). Pat to end of row. Turn. **21** (25-25-29-31-33) sts. Rep last 2 rows twice more. **17** (21-21-25-27-29) sts. Fasten off.

Right side: With RS facing, skip next **7** (11-11-11-11-15) sts. Join A with sl st to next ch-1 sp.

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. Pat to end of row. Turn. **24** (28-28-32-34-36) sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog over last 2 sts. Turn. **23** (27-27-31-33-35) sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn. **22** (26-26-30-32-34) sts. Rep last 2 rows twice more, then 2nd row once more. **17** (21-21-25-27-29) sts. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

With C, ch **50 (56-56-62-62-68)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from * to end of ch. Turn. **49 (55-55-61-61-67)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for Sc/Ch-1 pat until work from beg measures **8 (9-9-10-10-11)" [20.5 (23-23-25.5-25.5-28) cm]**. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, join A with sl st at right shoulder seam.

1st rnd: Ch 1. Work **21 (23-23-25-25-27)** sc along back neck, 8 sc down left front neck edge, **7 (9-9-11-11-13)** sc along front neck edge, 8 sc up right front neck edge. Join with sl st to first sc. **44 (48-48-52-52-56)** sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Bottom Edging: With RS facing, join D with sl st to rem loop of foundation ch at side seam.

1st rnd: Ch 1. Work **126 (150-158-174-190-206)** sc evenly around. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
