



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

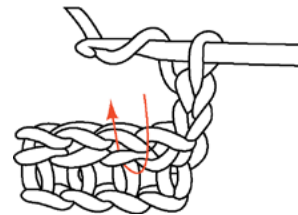
Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdchb = Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram)



Hdchb2tog = Yoh and draw up a loop in horizontal bar created below in previous row of each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama O'Go™ Halo (8 oz/227 g; 481 yds/440 m)

Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Graphite Frost (28006) 2 2 3 3 4 4 O'Gos

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
Yarn needle.

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

XS/S	28-34" [71-86.5 cm]
M	36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]
L	40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]
XL	44-46" [112-117 cm]
2/3XL	48-54" [122-137 cm]
4/5XL	56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished chest

XS/S	44" [112 cm]
M	48" [122 cm]
L	52" [132 cm]
XL	56" [142 cm]
2/3XL	60" [152.5 cm]
4/5XL	66" [167.5 cm]

GAUGE

12 sts and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in hdchb pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start crocheting!
- Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.
- Sweater is worked sideways, in one piece, from Cuff to Cuff.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Ch **56** (56-62-62-68-68).

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. **54** (54-60-60-66-66) hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until Sleeve measures 16" [40.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

BODY

Ch 48 (Front side edge).

1st row: (RS). 1 hdchb in each of next **54** (54-60-60-66-66) hdc of Sleeve. Ch 50. Turn.

2nd row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 47 ch. 1 hdchb in each of next **54** (54-60-60-66-66) hdc of Sleeve. 1 hdc in each of next 48 ch. Turn. **150** (150-156-156-162-162) sts. Rep last row until work from Side shaping measures **7¼** (8¼-9-10-10¾-12¼)" [**18.5** (21-23-25.5-27-31) cm], ending on a WS row.

Divide for Front neck: Next row:

(RS). Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each of next **75** (75-78-78-81-81) hdc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdchb2tog. Turn. **74** (74-77-77-80-80) sts.

Next row: Ch 2. Hdchb2tog. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **73** (73-76-76-79-79) sts.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until neck opening measures **6** (6-6½-6½-7-7)" [**15** (15-16.5-16.5-18-18) cm], ending on a WS row.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 2 hdc. 2 hdchb in next hdc. 1 hdchb in last hdc. Turn. **74** (74-77-77-80-80) sts.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in first hdc. 2 hdchb in next hdc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **75** (75-78-78-81-81) hdc.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Leave sts unworked.

Back neck: With RS facing, join yarn with sl st to first unworked st of neck divide.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in same st as sl st. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **75** (75-78-78-81-81) hdc.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 2. Hdchb2tog. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **74** (74-77-77-80-80) sts.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdchb2tog. Turn. **73** (73-76-76-79-79) sts.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until neck opening measures **6** (6-6½-6½-7-7)" [**15** (15-16.5-16.5-18-18) cm], ending on a RS row.

Next row: (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 2 hdc. 2 hdchb in next hdc. 1 hdchb in last hdc. Turn. **74 (74-77-77-80-80)** sts.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in first hdc. 2 hdchb in next hdc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **75 (75-78-78-81-81)** hdc.

Join Back and Front: Next row: (WS). Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. 1 hdchb in each of **75 (75-78-78-81-81)** hdc of Front. Turn. **150 (150-156-156-162-162)** hdc.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until piece from neck divide measures **7¼ (8¼-9-10-10¾-12¼)**" [**18.5 (21-23-25.5-27-31)** cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Shape Left Sleeve: With RS facing, skip next 48 hdc. Join yarn with sl st to next hdc.

1st row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in same st as sl st. 1 hdchb in each of next **53 (53-59-59-65-65)** hdc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **54 (54-60-60-66-66)** hdc.

Rep last row until Sleeve measures 16" [40.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold Pullover in half, aligning Sleeve and side seams. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

Neckband: Ch 7.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 6 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until work, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit around neck edge. Fasten off. Beg at left shoulder, sew neckband to neck edge. Sew neckband seam.
