## GAUGE

13 hdc and 10 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger hook.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- When working from chart use intarsia technique. Wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design.
- When changing yarn colors, work hdc to last 3 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 3 loops and proceed in new color, leaving old color at WS of work.
- Ch 2 at beg of rows counts as hdc throughout.


## FRONT

**Ribbing: With A and smaller hook, ch 11.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 10 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until Ribbing, when slightly stretched, measures 22 (24-26-28-30-32)" [56 (61-66-71-76-81.5) cm], ending on a RS row.

Rotate to work across side edge of ribbing.
1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Work 72 (78-86-92-98-104) sc evenly across side edge of Ribbing.
Fasten off. Do not turn. **
With RS facing and larger hook, join B with sl st to first sc.
Place Chart: 1st row: (RS). Ch 2 (counts as 1 st hdc of row). Work 1st row of Chart in hdc. Turn. See chart on page 4.

Cont to work Chart in hdc until 40 rows of Chart are complete, reading $R S$ rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. Break all colors but B.

With B only, cont even in hdc until work from lower edge (including ribbing) measures 191⁄2 (191/2-21½-21½-23-23)" [49.5 (49.5-54.5-54.5-58.5-58.5) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape left neck: 1 st row: (RS). Ch 2.1 hdc in each of next 23 (26-29-32-34-37) hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in next hdc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked. 26 (29-32-35-3740) sts.

2nd row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 hdc . Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.
4th row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. 23 (26-29-32-34-37) sts.
5th and 6th rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off.

Shape right neck: With RS facing, skip next 18 (18-20-20-22-22) unworked sts of Front. Join B with sl st to next hdc.
1st row: (RS). Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. 26 (29-32-35-37-40) sts.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to last 3 hdc. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.
4th row: As 2nd row. 23 (26-29-32-34-37) sts
5th and 6th rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Fasten off.

## BACK

Work from ** to ** as given for Front.

With RS facing and larger hook, join B with sl st to first sc.
1st row: (RS). Ch 2.1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until Back from lower edge (including ribbing) measures same length as Front to shoulder, ending on a WS row.
Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

Ribbing: With D and smaller hook, ch 11.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 10 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until Ribbing when slightly stretched measures 9 (9-10-10-11-11)" [23 (23-25.5-25.5-28-28) cm], ending on a RS row.

Rotate to work across side edge of ribbing.
1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Work 30 (30-34-34-36-36) sc evenly across side edge of Ribbing. Break D. Join B. Turn.

Change to larger hook.
2nd row: (WS). With B, ch 2.1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
3rd row (inc row): Ch 2.2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn. 2 sts inc'd.
Rep last 2 rows 4 (4-12-12-12-12) times more. 40 (40-60-60-6262) sts.

Sizes XS/S and M only: Next 3 rows: Ch 2.1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Next row (inc row): (RS). Ch 2. 2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc .2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn. 2 sts inc'd. Rep last 4 rows 5 times more. 52 sts.

All sizes: 52 (52-60-60-62-62) sts. Next row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Sleeve from lower edge (including Ribbing) measures $181 / 2(171 / 2-17-16-151 / 2$ 15)" [47 (44.5-43-40.5-39.5-38) cm ], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.
Neck edging: With RS facing and smaller hook, join B with sl st to neck edge at right shoulder seam. 1st rnd: Ch 1. Work sc evenly around neck edge. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.


Neckband: With A and smaller hook, ch 8.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Neckband measures length to fit around neck edge, when slightly stretched. Sew long edge of Neckband to neck edging, beg at right shoulder seam. Sew ends of Neckband tog.

Place markers on each side edge of Front and Back 8 (8-9-9-91/2-91/2)" [20.5 (20.5-23-23-24-24) cm], down from shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.
