## GAUGE

15 sts and 18 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pattern.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- Ch 1 or ch 2 at beg of row do not count as stitch.
- Body is worked in one piece to armholes.


## STRIPE PAT

With A, work 4 rows. With C, work 4 rows. With F, work 4 rows.
With I, work 4 rows.
With E, work 4 rows.
With B, work 4 rows.
With G, work 4 rows.
With H, work 4 rows.
With D, work 4 rows.
These 36 rows form Stripe Pat.

## BODY

With A, ch 162 (174-188-204 -218-242).
Note: Do not work sl sts too tightly or you may find it difficult working into them throughout pat.

1st row: (RS). SI st in 2nd ch from hook. *1 hdc in next ch. Sl st in next ch. Rep from * to end of chain. Turn. 161 (173-187-203-217-241) sts.
2nd row: Ch 2 (does not count as st). 1 hdc in first sl st. *Sl st in next hdc. 1 hdc in next sl st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. SI st in first hdc. *1 hdc in next sl st. Sl st in next hdc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
First 3 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Rep last 2 rows for pat, AT SAME TIME, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until work from beg measures 20" [51 cm], ending on a WS row.

## Divide for armholes:

Right Front: 1st row: (RS). Pat across 39 (43-45-47-51-55) sts. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
2nd row: Work even in pat.
3rd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.
Rep last 2 rows 14 (16-12-11-14-
14) times more. 24 (26-32-35-3640) sts.

Sizes $L, X L, 2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 X L$ only: Next 3 rows: Beg on a WS row, work even in pat.
Next row: (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. Pat to end of row. Turn.
Rep last 4 rows (1-2-1-1) time(s) more. (30-32-34-38) sts.

All Sizes: Cont even in pat until armhole measures 9 ( $91 / 2-91 / 2-10-$ 10-10½)" [23 (24-24-25.5-25.526.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Back: With RS facing, skip next 4 (4-4-8-8-12) sts. Rejoin appropriate color with sl st to next st. Pat across 75 (79-89-93-99107) sts (including joining st). Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 9 ( $\left.91 / 2-9 \frac{1}{2}-10-10-101 / 2\right)^{\prime \prime}$ [23 (24-24-25.5-25.5-26.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.
Place markers on final row 24 (26-30-32-34-38) sts in from each side edge for shoulders.

Left Front: With RS facing, skip next 4 (4-4-8-8-12) sts.
1st row: Rejoin appropriate color with sl st to next st. Pat across 39 (43-45-47-51-55) sts (including joining st). Turn.
2nd row: Work even in pat.
3rd row: Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
Rep last 2 rows 14 (16-12-11-14-
14) times more. 24 (26-32-35-36-
40) sts.

Sizes $L, X L, 2 / 3 X L$ and $4 / 5 X L$ only: Next 3 rows: Beg on a WS row, work even in pat.
Next row: (RS). Pat to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.
Rep last 4 rows (1-2-1-1) time(s) more. (30-32-34-38) sts.

All Sizes: Cont even in pat until armhole measures 9 ( $91 / 2-91 / 2-10-$ 10-101/2)" [23 (24.5-24.5-25.5-25.5-26.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With A ch 42 (44-44-48-48-52).
1st row: (RS). Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. *1 hdc in next ch. Sl st in next ch. Rep from * to end of chain. Turn. 41 (43-43-47-47-51) sts.
2nd row: Ch 2 (does not count as st). 1 hdc in first sl st. *SI st in next hdc. 1 hdc in next sl st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1. SI st in first hdc. *1 hdc in next sl st. Sl st in next hdc. Rep from* to end of row. Turn.
First 3 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Rep last 2 rows for pat, AT SAME TIME, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until work from beg measures 4" $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending on a WS row.

Keeping cont of pat, shape sides of Sleeve as follows:
1st row: (RS). Ch 2. (1 hdc. SI st) in first hdc. *1 hdc in next sl st. Sl st in next hdc. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 hdc in next sl st. (Sl st. 1 hdc ) in last hdc. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1. SI st in first hdc. *1 hdc in next sl st. Sl st in next hdc. Rep from* to end of row.Turn. 3rd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first sl st. *SI st in next hdc. 1 hdc in next sl st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
4th row: As 2nd row.
5th row: Ch 1. (SI st. 1 hdc) in first sl st. *Sl st in next hdc. 1 hdc in next sl st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. SI st in next hdc. (1 hdc. Sl st) in last sl st. Turn.
6th row: As 3rd row.
7th row: As 2nd row.
8th row: As 3rd row.
Rep last 8 rows 5 (6-6-6-6-6) times more, then 1st to 4th rows 1 (0-0-0-0-0) time(s) more, taking inc sts into pat. 67 (71-71-75-75-79) sts. 29

Cont even in pat until Sleeve measures 18 (18-18-17-17-16)" [45.5 (45.5-45.5-43-43-40.5) cm], ending on a WS row. Place markers at each end of last row.
Work a further 2 (2-2-4-4-6) rows even in pat. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams to markers. Sew in sleeves placing rows above markers along unworked sts of Body to form square armholes.

Front Edging: 1 st row: (RS). Join A with sl st in bottom corner of Right Front. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly up Right Front, across back neck and down Left Front. Turn.
2nd to 5th rows: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Fasten off.
