## GAUGE

12 sts and 10 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Texture Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for XS/S. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- Yarn has gradual changing color from Color A to Color B. Determine for yourself what shade will be $A$ and $B$.
- Join second ball of yarn, matching color from previous ball, letting colors change gradually. Excess of yarn can be used after for Front edging.
- Start each sleeve with new ball to be able match color flow on both sleeves. Excess of yarn can be used after for Front edging.
- Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as st.
- Body is worked in one piece to armholes at which point Backs and Fronts are worked separately.


## BODY <br> **Ribbing

Ch 9.
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 8 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until ribbing measures 43 (47-51-54-59-64)" [109 (119.5-129.5-137-150-162.5) cm], when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. (Do not fasten off)

Next row: (RS). Ch 1. Work 129 (143-153-161-177-193) sc evenly across side edge of Ribbing. Turn.

Proceed in Texture Pat as follows:
1st row: (WS). Ch 1. Sl st in first st.
*1 dc in next st. SI st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn.
Last 2 rows form Texture Pat.

Cont in Texture Pat until work from beg measures 22" [ 56 cm ], ending on a WS row.

## Divide for armholes:

LEFT FRONT: Shape armhole and front: Next row: (RS).
Ch 2. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in each of next 24 (28-30-32-34-36) sts. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Cont working on 25 (29-31-33-3537) sts.

Next row: Ch 1. Sl st in first st. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
Next row: Ch 2. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. 23 (27-29-31-33-35) sts.
Rep last 2 rows 0 (0-1-1-2-3) time(s) more. 23 (27-27-29-29-29) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: Ch 1. Sl st in first st. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. 22 (26-26-28-28-28) sts.
3rd row: Ch 2. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
4th row: As 2nd row. 21 (25-25-27-27-27) sts.
Rep these 4 rows 3 (4-4-4-4-4) times more. 15 (17-17-19-1919) sts.

Cont even in Texture Pat until armhole measures 9 (9-10-10-11-111/2)" [23 (23-25.5-25.5-2829) cm ], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## BACK

Note: When joining yarn find the best match of shade to ensure ombre effect flows well.

With RS facing, skip next 8 (8-8-8-12-16) sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st. Ch 2.1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each of next 58 (64-70-74-78-82) sts. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.
Cont working on 59 (65-71-75-7983) sts.

Cont even in Texture Pat until armhole measures 9 (9-10-10-11$111 / 2$ )" [23 (23-25.5-25.5-28-29) cm ], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

When joining yarn find the best match of shade to ensure ombre effect flows well.

1st row: (RS). Skip next 8 (8-8-8-12-
16) sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st. Ch 2.1 hdc in same sp as last sl st. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc3tog. Turn. 25 (29-31-33-3537) sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. SI st in first st. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 2. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. 23 (27-27-29-29-29) sts.

Proceed as follows:
1st row: Ch 1. Sl st in first st. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 2 . Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. Turn. 22 (26-26-28-28-28) sts.
3rd row: Ch 2. *1 dc in next st. SI st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
4th row: As 2nd row. 21 (25-25-27-27-27) sts.
Rep these 4 rows 3 (4-4-4-4-4) times more. 15 (17-17-19-19-19) sts.

Cont even in Texture Pat unti armhole measures 9 (9-10-10-11$111 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$ [23 (23-25.5-25.5-28-29) cm ], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

## Ribbing: Ch 9.

1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 8 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until ribbing measures $91 / 2\left(9 \frac{1}{2}-11-11-121 / 2-12^{11 / 2}\right.$ )" [24 (24-28-28-32-32) cm], when slightly stretched, ending on a WS row. (Do not fasten off)

Next row: (RS). Ch 2. Work 29 (29-33-33-37-37) hdc evenly across long edge of ribbing.

Proceed in Texture Pat as follows: 1st row: (WS). Ch 1. Sl st in first st. *1 dc in next st. Sl st in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 2.2 hdc in first st. 1 hdc in each st to last st. 2 hdc in last st.
Turn. 31 (31-35-35-39-39) hdc.
3rd row: Ch 2. *1 dc in next st. SI st in next st. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

4th row: As 2nd row. 33 (33-37-37-41-41) hdc.
Rep these 4 rows 6 (6-6-6-6-7) times more, then rep 1st and 2 nd rows 0 (0-0-0-1-1) time more. 57 (57-61-61-67-71) sts.

Cont even in Texture Pat until Sleeve measures 18½ (181/2-18-18-17-17)" [47 (47-45.5-45.5-43-43) cm] from beg, ending on a WS row. PM at each end of last row.
Work a further 2 (2-2-2-4-6) rows even in Texture Pat. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.
Neck Edging: 1st row: (RS). Join yarn with sl st at lower edge of Right Front. Ch 1. Work 1 row of sc evenly up Right Front, across Back neck edge and down Left Front. Turn.
2nd row: (WS). Ch 1.1 scbl in each st to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until Neck Edging measures 4 (4-41/2-41/2-5-5)" [10 (10-11.5-11.5-12.5-12.5) cm]. Fasten off.

Sew in Sleeves placing rows above markers along unworked sts of Front and Back to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.
