#### **BACK AND FRONT** (make 2 alike)

#### **Upper Stripe Pat**

Note: This section is worked using inner variegated section of each cake.

Work 2 rows of A (variegated). Work 2 rows of B (variegated). These 4 rows form Upper Stripe Pat.

#### Ch 30 (34-38-42-46-46).

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 13 (15-17-19-21-21) ch. Ch 2. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 28 (32-36-40-44-44) sts.

2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to end of row. 32 (36-40-44-48-48) sts.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are now complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

Rep 2nd row 13 (14-15-17-21-25) times more. PM at end of last row. 84 (92-100-112-132-148) sts.

Upper Stripe Pat is now complete. Work Body as follows:

**Body Stripe Pat** Note: This section is worked using the outer solid part of each cake. Work 4 rows of A (solid).

Work 4 rows of B (solid). These 8 rows form Body Stripe Pat.

#### Sizes XS/S, M, and L only:

1st row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 86 (94-102) sts.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last 4 sts. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. These 4 rows form pat.

Keeping cont of Body Stripe Pat, rep these 4 rows 9 times more. 104 (112-120) sts. Fasten off.

#### Sizes XL, 2/3XL, and 4/5XL only:

1st row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last 3 sts. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. 114 (134-150) sts.

2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first st. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in each st to ch-2 sp. (2 hdc. Ch 2. 2 hdc) in ch-2 sp. 1 hdc in each st to last 4 sts. Hdc3tog. 1 hdc in last st. Turn. These 2 rows form pat.

Keeping cont of Body Stripe Pat, rep these 2 rows 19 times more. 152 (172-188) sts. Fasten off.

> Ch 30. Fasten off. Rep for rem 3 ties
