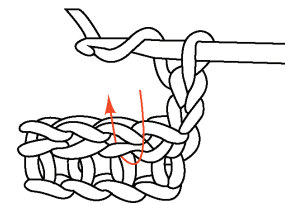

Hdchb = Work 1 hdc into horizontal bar created below in previous row (bar is below loops normally worked on WS – see diagram)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

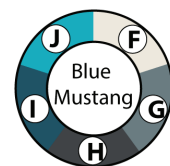
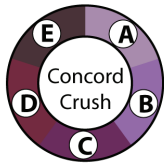
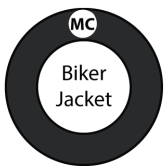
MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama™ O'Go™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 228 yds/208 m)

Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Main Color (MC)

Sizes U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) and U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S	28-34" [71-86.5 cm]
M	36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]
L	40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]
XL	44-46" [112-117 cm]
2/3XL	48-54" [122-137 cm]
4/5XL	56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust

XS/S	40" [101.5 cm]
M	43" [109 cm]

XL	51" [129.5 cm]

GAUGES

10 sc and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

Motif = Approx 4¾" [12 cm] square with smaller hook.

10 sts and 8½ rows = 4" [10 cm] in hdchb pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove
- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A to J). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A to J.
- Front worked in 3 steps: Granny Squares Panel, Top Section and Sides.
- Ribbing for Front is worked side to side and sewn later to lower edge of Front.
- Back and Sleeves are worked side-to-side.

Granny Squares Panel (see diagrams on page 5)

Motif 1: Make **2** (2-2-2-3-3) Color 1 – C, Color 2 – B, Color 3 – A.

Motif 2: Make **2** (2-2-2-3-3) Color 1 – C, Color 2 – D, Color 3 – E.

Motif 3: Make **1** (1-2-2-2-2) Color 1 – A, Color 2 – B, Color 3 – C.

Motif 4: Make **1** (1-2-2-2-2) Color 1 – E, Color 2 – D, Color 3 – B.

Motif 5: Make **2** (2-2-2-3-3) Color 1 – F, Color 2 – G, Color 3 – H.

Motif 6: Make **2** (2-2-2-3-3) Color 1 – F, Color 2 – J, Color 3 – I.

Motif 7: Make **1** (1-2-2-2-2) Color 1 – H, Color 2 – G, Color 3 – F.

Motif 8: Make **1** (1-2-2-2-2) Color 1 – G, Color 2 – I, Color 3 – J.

Granny Motif

Notes:

- Ch 3 counts as dc at beg of rnd.
- Join all rnds with sl st to top of first ch 3.

See diagram on page 5.

With Color 1 and smaller hook, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

1st rnd: With Color 1, ch 3. [2 dc. (Ch 2. 3 dc) 3 times] all in ring. Ch 2. Join. Fasten off.

2nd rnd: Join Color 2 with sl st to any ch-2 sp. Ch 3. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in first ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Join. Fasten off.

3rd rnd: Join Color 3 with sl st to any ch-2 sp. Ch 3. 2 dc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in first ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Join. Fasten off.

Granny Squares Panel: Following Diagram (see page 5), sew Motifs tog using whip stitch and matching color.

FRONT

Top Section

With larger hook, join MC with sl st to top right corner of Granny Squares Panel.

1st row: (RS – pick up row). Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. Work **37** (37-49-49-61-61) more sc across top edge of Granny Squares Panel. Turn. **38** (38-50-50-62-62) sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from pick-up row measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape left neck edge: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next **11 (11-16-16-21-19)** sc. Sc2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. **Turn.** **11 (11-16-16-21-19)** sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. **Turn.** **10 (10-15-15-20-18)** sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

Rep last row until work from pick-up row measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Shape right neck edge: With RS facing, skip next **12 (12-14-14-16-18)** sc. Join MC with sl st to next sc. **1st row:** (RS). Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. **Turn.** **11 (11-16-16-21-19)** sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. **Turn.** **10 (10-15-15-20-18)** sts.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

Rep last row until work from pick-up row measures 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Left Side Section

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rows **does not** count as st.

With larger hook, join MC with sl st to bottom left corner of Granny Squares Panel.

1st row: (RS – pick up row). Ch 2. Work 62 hdc evenly up left side. **Turn.**

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

Rep last row until work from pick up row measures **2 (3½-2-3-2-3)" [5 (9-5-7.5-5-7.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Right Side Section

With larger hook, join MC with sl st to top right corner of Top Front Section.

1st row: (RS – pick up row). Ch 2. Work 62 hdc evenly down right side of Front. **Turn.**

Work as given for Left Side Section.

Ribbing: With MC and larger hook, ch 7.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. **Turn.** 6 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. **Turn.**

Rep last row until Ribbing, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit bottom edge of Front, ending on a RS row. Sew to bottom of Front as you go. Fasten off at end of last row.

BACK

Note: Back is worked side-to-side.

With MC and larger hook, ch 64.

1st row: (RS). With A, 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each of next 55 ch. 1 sc in each of last 6 ch. **Turn.** 62 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each st to end of row. **Turn.**

3rd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each of next 56 hdc. 1 scbl in each of last 6 sc. **Turn.**

Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures **6 (7½-8-9-10-10½)" [15 (19-20.5-23-25.5-26.5) cm]**, ending on a 3rd row.

Shape right back neck: 1st row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 4 hdc. Hdchb2tog. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. PM at end of row.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each st to last 6 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 6 sc. **Turn.**

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. **Turn.**

Rep last 2 rows until work from marked row measures **6 (6-7-7-8-9)" [15 (15-18-18-20.5-23) cm]**, ending on a 2nd row.



Shape left back neck: 1st row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last hdc. 2 hdchb in last hdc. PM on last st. Ch 4. Turn.

2nd row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 6 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 6 sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each st to last 6 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 6 sc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until work from marker measures **6 (7½-8-9-10-10½)" [15 (19-20.5-23-25.5-26.5) cm]**, ending on a 3rd row. Fasten off.

Ribbing: With MC and smaller hook, ch 14.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 13 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until Ribbing, measures length to fit bottom edge of Back, ending on a RS row. Sew to bottom of Back as you go. Fasten off at end of last row.

SLEEVES

Note: Sleeves are worked side to side. To avoid large steps of side sleeve shaping, increase rows and decrease rows **do not** match.

With MC and larger hook, ch **14 (14-11-11-10-10)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. **12 (12-9-9-8-8)** hdc.

2nd row: Ch **13 (13-11-11-10-8)**. 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each of next **10 (10-8-8-7-5)** ch. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **23 (23-18-18-16-14)** hdc.

3rd row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows **2 (2-3-3-3-4)** times more. **45 (45-45-45-40-38)** hdc.

Next row: (WS). Ch 7. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each of next 5 ch. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn. **51 (51-51-51-46-44)** sts. PM at beg of row.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last 6 sc. 1 scbl in each of last 6 sc. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 6 sc. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows until work from marked row measures **10 (11-10-11-12-12)" [25.5 (28-25.5-28-30.5-30.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Next row: (RS). Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each of next **45 (45-45-45-40-38)** hdc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to last **11 (11-9-9-8-6)** hdc. Turn. Leave rem sts unworked.

Rep last 2 rows **2 (2-3-3-3-4)** times more. **12 (12-9-9-8-8)** hdc.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdchb in each hdc to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

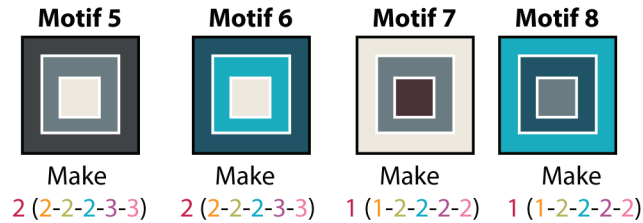
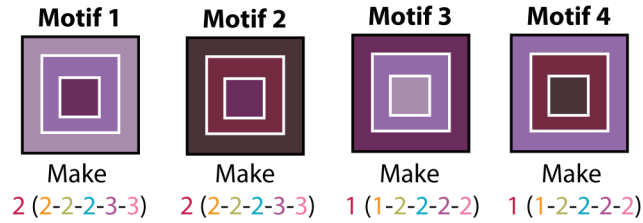
Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry. Sew shoulder seams. PM **8½ (9-9½-10-10½-11½)" [21.5 (23-24-25.5-26.5-29) cm]** on each side of Front and Back down from shoulders. Sew sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband: With MC and smaller hook, ch 8.

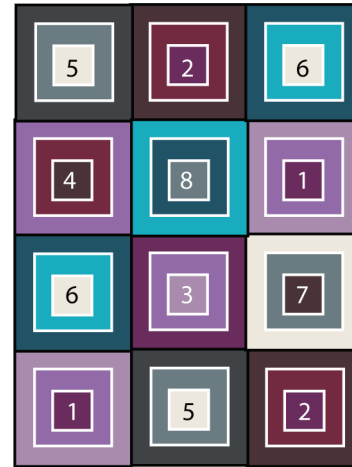
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 7 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each sc to end of row. Turn.

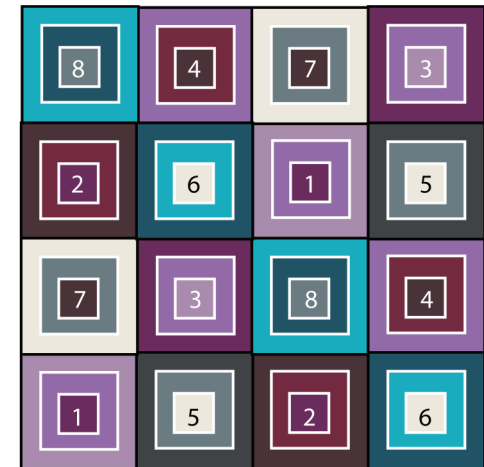
Rep last row until work, when slightly stretched, measures length to fit around neck edge. Fasten off. Beg at left shoulder, sew neck edging around neck edge. Sew neckband seam.



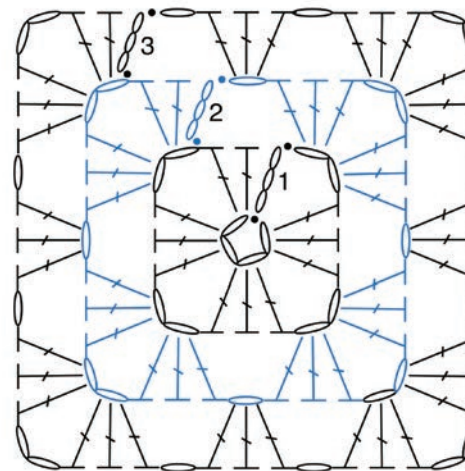
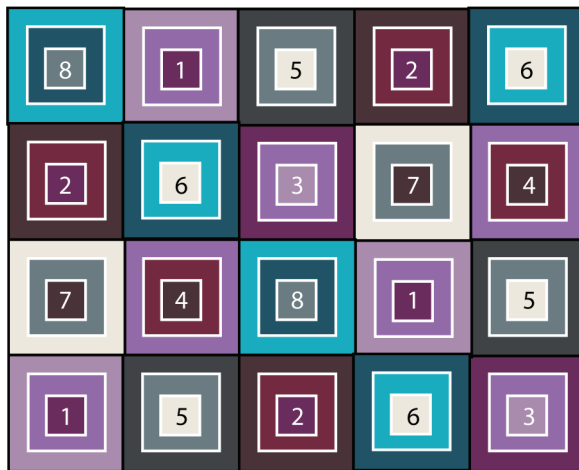
Granny Square Panel - Sizes XS/S, M



Granny Square Panel - Sizes L, XL



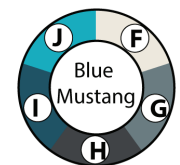
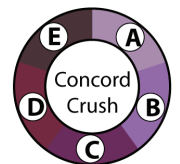
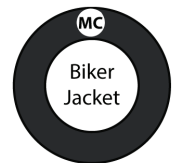
Granny Square Panel - Sizes 2/3XL - 4/5XL



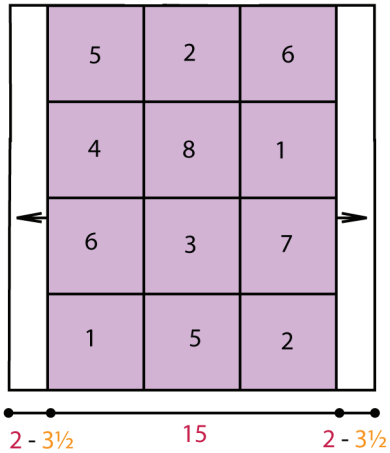
GRANNY SQUARE

STITCH KEY

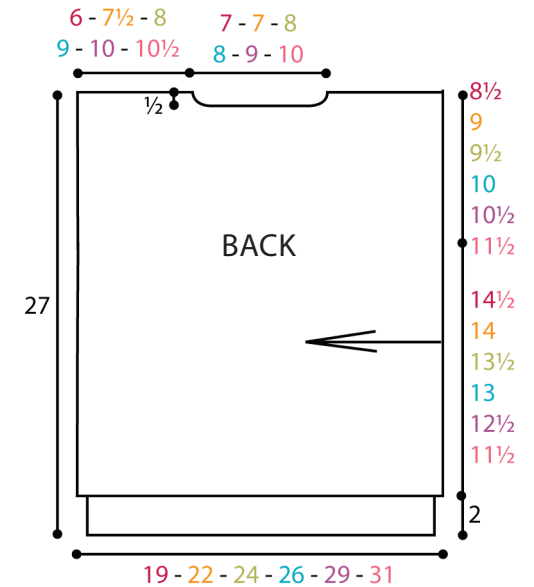
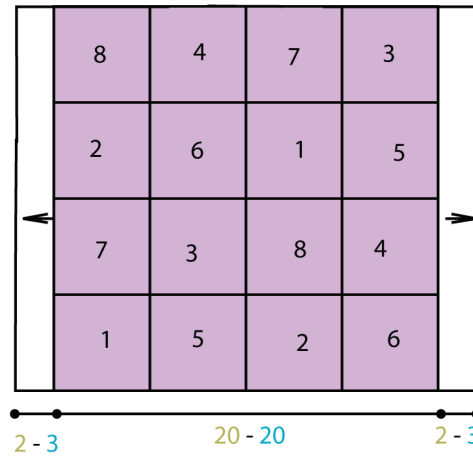
- = slip stitch (sl st)
