



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]

M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]

L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]

XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]

2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]

4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust measurement

XS/S 40" [101.5 cm]

M 43" [109 cm]

L 46" [117 cm]

XL 52" [132 cm]

2/3XL 58" [147.5 cm]

2/3XL 65" [165 cm]

MATERIALS

Caron® Angel Cakes™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 530 yds/485 m)

Sizes **XS/S** **M** **L** **XL** **2/3XL** **4/5XL**

Faded Jeans (36003) **2** **2** **3** **3** **4** **4** balls

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

GAUGE

17 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rows **does not** count as st.

Ch **87 (93-99-113-125-141) loosely.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. **85 (91-97-111-123-139)** dc.

2nd row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first st. *1 dcbp around post of next st. 1 dcbp around post of next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dcbp around post of next st. 1 hdc in last st. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. *1 dcbp around post of next st. 1 dcbp around post of next st. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dcbp around post of next st. 1 hdc in last hdc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows once more, then 2nd row once.

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. *Ch 1. Skip next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until piece measures **12 (12-12-13-14-14)" [30.5 (30.5-30.5-33-35.5-35.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row.

Shape armholes: 1st row: (WS). Sl st in each of first **4 (4-4-6-8-8)** sts. Ch 1. 1 sc in same st as last sl st. Pat to last **3 (3-3-5-7-7)** sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. **79 (85-91-101-109-125)** sts.**

Cont even in pat until armhole measures **5½ (5½-6-6-6½-6½)" [14 (14-15-15-16.5-16.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1. Pat across **21 (23-25-29-33-41)** sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked. Work 8 rows even in pat over these **21 (23-25-29-33-41)** sts. Fasten off.

With WS facing, skip next **37 (39-41-43-43-43)** sts. Join yarn with sl st to next st.

1st row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in same st as last sl st. Pat to end of row. Turn. Work 8 rows even in pat over these **21 (23-25-29-33-41)** sts. Fasten off.

BACK

Work from ** to ** as given for Front.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Front to shoulder. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder and side seams.

Neck Edging: (RS). Join yarn with sl st to right shoulder. Ch 1. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around neck edge. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Armhole Edging: Work as given for Neck Edging around each armhole.
