Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Coconut Cakes ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $8 \mathrm{oz} / 227 \mathrm{~g} ; 481 \mathrm{yds} / 440 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Sizes

| Tutti-Frutti (84002) | 2 | 2 | cakes |

Size U.S. 7 ( 4.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\oplus}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 64" [162.5 cm] wide from cuff-to-cuff by 21 (24)" [53.5 (61) cm ] long before sewing.

## GAUGE

16 sts and 7 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in pattern (pat).

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for XS/S/M. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written XS/S/M (L/XL/2XL). When only one number is given it applies to both sizes.

## Notes:

- Ch 5 at beg of row counts as dc and ch-2 sp.
- Sleeves are worked flat in one piece from front to back then seamed.

Ch 260 (multiple of $3+5$ ).
1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. 1 double crochet (dc) in 8th chain (ch) from hook (counts as skipped $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and ch-2). *Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch . 1 dc in next ch. Repeat (rep) from * to end of chain. Turn. 86 dc and 85 ch-2 spaces (sps).
2nd row: Ch 5 (counts as dc and ch-2 sp here and throughout). Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. Rep last row until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 10 (11/2/2)" [25.5 (29) cm], ending on a Wrong Side (WS) row.

## Shape neck opening: 1 st row:

(RS). Ch 5. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc.** Rep from * 33 times more. Ch 44. Skip next 44 sts. 1 dc in next dc. Neck Opening made. Rep from * to ** 35 times more. Turn. 72 dc , $70 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$, and $1 \mathrm{ch}-44 \mathrm{sp}$.
2nd row: Ch 5. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. *Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc.** Rep from * 34 times more. (Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch .1 dc in next ch.) 12 times. Ch 2. Skip next 2 ch .1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to ** 36 times more. Turn. 86 dc and $85 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
3rd row: Ch 5. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. ${ }^{*}$ Ch 2. Skip next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from* to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures approx. 21 (24)" [53.5 (61) cm], ending on a RS row.

## FINISHING

Place markers 20 (161/2)" [51 (42) cm ] in from each side along foundation chain and last row of work.
Fold work in half lengthwise with WS together (tog). Using Flat sl st, join first and last rows tog from side edges to markers. Weave in ends.
