MATERIALS

Caron® Jumbo Ombre™ (12 oz/340 q; 595 yds/544 m)

White Water (19007)

2 balls

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Tapestry needle.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Rnd(s) = Round(s)**Beg** = Beginning Ch = Chain(s)**SI st** = Slip stitch **Cont** = Continue(ity) Sp(s) = Space(s)Dc = Double crochetSt(s) = Stitch(es) Tog = Together **Rep** = Repeat

SIZE

One size to fit child ages 4 to 8.

GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc. All rnds are joined with sl st to first st.

SMALL GRANNY SQUARES (make 4)

See diagram on page 3. Beg using magic loop method, demonstrated here.

**1st rnd: Ch 3. 2 dc in ring. Ch 2. (3 dc in ring. Ch 2) 3 times. Join with sl st to first st. Sl st into first ch-2 sp.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in first ch-2 sp. [(Ch 1. 3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next ch-2 sp] 3 times. Ch 1. Join. SI st into first ch-2 sp. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in first corner ch-2 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. *(Ch 1. 3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next in corner ch-2 sp. Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around. Join. SI st into next ch-2 sp.



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4th rnd: Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in first corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice. *(Ch 1. 3 dc. Stitch from A/B to C to complete Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice. Rep from * around. SLEEVES Join. SI st into next ch-2 sp. **5th rnd:** Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in first corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc 1st rnd: Ch 3. 2 dc in ch-sp. Ch 1. 3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) all in next in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. Rep from * around. Join. SI st into next ch-2 sp. Fasten off.**

LARGE GRANNY SQUARES (make 3)

Work as for Small Granny Squares from ** to **.

5th to 10th rnds: Cont as established, working (Ch 1. 3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in each corner ch-2 sp, and working (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp. Fasten off.

Assemble Body

Lay out granny squares according to Assembly Diagram and stitch tog with tapestry needle as indicated with red lines. Leave sections marked with green lines open for armholes.

Once all seams marked in red are sewn, fold so points A and B meet. Hood seam.

Join yarn with sl st io any ch-sp along armhole.

in next ch-1 sp) 3 times. *(Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-sp. Ch 1. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first st. Sl st to next ch-sp.

> 2nd rnd: Cont as established in first rnd, working (3 dc. Ch 1) in each ch-

3rd to 18th rnds: As 2nd rnd. 19th rnd: Ch 1. Work 2 sc in each ch-1 sp around. Join.


20th to 24th rnds: Ch 1, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Add Length to Bottom of Jacket (optional)

Join yarn with sl st to bottom corner of Jacket to work along bottom edge.

***1st row: Ch 3. 3 dc in first ch-sp. Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to end of row, working 1 dc in last st. Turn.



Ch 1. *3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from * to end of row, working 1 dc in last st. Turn.***

Cont as established until Jacket reaches desired length. Fasten off.

2nd row: Ch 3. 3 dc in first ch-1 sp. Add Width to Bottom of Jacket (optional)


Join yarn with sl st to bottom corner of Jacket to work across Fronts and Hood of Jacket.

Work from *** to *** as given for Bottom of Jacket until desired width is reached. Fasten off.
