DESCRIPTION SIZING

Hop along, now, and crochet yourself a mother \& baby kangaroo.

## Abbreviations

$\mathrm{Ch}(\mathrm{s})=$ Chain(s)
Dc = double crochet
hdc $=$ half double crochet
sc = single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in next st) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook
SI st = Slip stitch

## Mama measures

approximately
$10 " / 25.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ tall, including ears; Joey measures approximately $5 " / 12.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ tall, including ears. Note: The ears add about $1 / 2 " / 1.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ to height.

## GAUGE

Gauge is not critical for this project.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## NOTES

1. Pieces are worked in continuous rounds, with RS facing throughout. Do not turn and do not join at the end of rounds. Place a marker to indicate the end of the first round and move the marker up as work progresses.
2. Gauge is not critical. Work tightly, so stuffing will not show through stitches.
3. To reduce finishing time, weave in ends as work progresses.

## MAMA

Head
Beginning at top of head, with larger hook, ch 2.
Round 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn- 6 sc .
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 18 sc .
Round 4: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next Sc] 6 times- 24 sc.
Round 5: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 30 sc .
Rounds 6-12: Sc in each sc around.
Round 13: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 6 times-24 sc.
Round 14: Sc in each sc around.
Round 15: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times-18 sc.
Neck
Rounds 16-20: Sc in each sc around.
Body
Round 21: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times-24 sc.
Rounds 22-24: Sc in each sc around.
Round 25: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 30 sc .
Rounds 26-28: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 29: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 36 sc .
Round 30: Sc in each sc around.
Round 31: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times-42 sc.
Round 32: Sc in each sc around.
Round 33: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 10 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-52 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 34 and 35: Sc in each sc around.
Round 36: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 10 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-62 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 37 and 38: Sc in each sc around.
Round 39: [Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 10 times, sc in next 2 sc- 72 sc.
Rounds 40 and 41: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 42: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 12 times- 60 sc .
Round 43: [Sc in next 3 sc , sc2tog] 12 times-48 sc.
Stuff head and body. Continue to stuff piece as work progresses.
Round 44: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ] 12 times- 36 sc .
Round 45: Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 12 times- 24 sc .
Round 46: Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 8 times-16 sc.
Round 47: [Sc2tog] 8 times- 8 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle, weave tail through stitches of last round. Pull gently, but firmly, to close opening. Tie securely and weave in end.

## MUZZLE

Beginning at center front of muzzle, with larger hook, ch 2.
Round 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn- 6 sc .
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Rounds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times-18 sc.
Rounds 6 and 7: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 8: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 24 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff muzzle and sew to lower, center front of head.

## EARS (make 2)

With larger hook, ch 11.
Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), hdc in next 3 ch, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; rotate piece to work across opposite side of foundation ch (do not turn piece over, keep same side facing you), sc
in next 3 ch , hdc in next 3 ch , dc in last 2 ch , turn-19 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in first 9 sts, 3 sc in next st (at tip), sc in last 9 sts- 21 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew one ear to each side of head, toward the back.
ARMS (make 2)
Beginning at top of arm, with larger hook, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 7 sc in'2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn-7 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around- 14 sc .
Rounds 3-8: Sc in each sc around.
Rounds 9 and 10: SI st in next 4 sc , hdc in next 6 sc , sl st in next 4 sts.
Round 11: Sc in next 4 sl sts, hdc in next $6 \mathrm{hdc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next 4 sl sts.
Round 12: Sc in next 3 sc , [sc2tog] 4 times, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}-10 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 13: Sc in each sc around.
Stuff piece. Continue to stuff piece as work progresses.
Round 14: Sc in first 3 sc , [sc2tog] 2 times, sc in last $3 \mathrm{sc}-8 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 15: Sc in each sc around.
Round 16: Sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last sc-10 sc.
Rounds 17 and 18: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 19: [Sc2tog] 5 times- 5 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle, weave tail through stitches of last round. Pull gently, but firmly, to close opening. Tie securely. Using remaining long tail, sew one arm to each side of body, below neck.

## LEGS (make 2)

Beginning at top of leg, with larger hook, ch 2.
Round 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn- 8 sc .
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around- 16 sc .
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 8 times- 24 sc .
Round 4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 8 times- 32 sc .
Rounds 6-10: Sc in each sc around.
Round 11: [Sc in next 2 sc , sc2tog] 8 times- 24 sc .
Round 12: Sc in each sc around.
Round 13: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 8 times- 16 sc.
Rounds 14 and 15: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 16: [Sc in next 2 sc , sc2tog] 4 times- 12 sc .
Rounds 17 and 18: Sc in each sc around.
Round 19: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 18 sc .
Rounds 20-23: Sc in each sc around.
Stuff piece lightly. Continue to stuff piece as work progresses.
Round 24: [Sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times-20 sc.
Rounds 25-30: Sc in each sc around.
Round 31: [Sc in next 2 sc , sc2tog] 5 times- 15 sc .
Round 32: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 5 times- 10 sc.
Round 33: Sc 2 tog 5 times- 5 sc .
Fasten off, leaving a very long tail. With yarn needle, weave tail through stitches of last round. Pull gently, but
firmly, to close opening. Tie securely, do not cut tail, use tail to shape and sew one leg to each side of body, as follows: Flatten top of leg (widest end) slightly and pin it to the side of the body, below the arm. Fold the leg slightly so the foot is positioned to the floor and tack the foot to the leg. Sew the leg to the body. With yarn needle and another length of yarn, sew 2 lines into each foot to form toes. Weave in ends.

## TAIL

Beginning at tip of tail, with larger hook, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2 nd ch from hook-6 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Rounds 2-6: Sc in each sc around.
Round 7: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times- 8 sc .
Rounds 8-10: Sc in each sc around.
Round 11: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times- 10 sc .
Rounds 12-15: Sc in each sc around.
Round 16: [ Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times-12 sc.
Rounds 17 and 18: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 19: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times- 14 sc .
Stuff piece. Continue to stuff piece as work progresses.
Rounds 20 and 21: Sc in each sc around.
Round 22: [Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times- 16 sc .
Round 23: Sc in each sc around.
Round 24: [ Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times, sc in next sc-19 sc.
Rounds 25 and 26: Sc in each sc around.
Round 27: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times, sc in next sc-22 sc.
Round 28: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. With yarn needle, sew tail to bottom back, centered between legs.
Weave in end.

## POUCH

Beginning at lower edge, with larger hook, ch 29.
Row 1: Working in back bars only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn- 28 sc .
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc , turn- 30 sc .
Rows 3-19: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Fasten off, leaving a very long tail for sewing. With yarn needle, sew sides and bottom of pouch to front of body
between legs, gather bottom of pouch to fit.

## FINISHING (Mama)

With yarn needle and brown yarn, using photograph as a guide, embroider straight st eyes on face about $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 1.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ tall and about $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} / 2 \mathrm{~cm}$ apart, above muzzle. Embroider straight st nostrils about $1 / 4 " / 0.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ apart and about 1 " $/ 2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ from end of muzzle. Embroider straight st mouth at end of muzzle.

## JOEY

Head
Beginning at top of head, with smaller hook, ch 2 .
Round 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn-6 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 4 times-16 sc.
Rounds 4-6: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 7: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 4 times-12 sc.
Round 8: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 4 times-8 sc.
Neck
Rounds 9-10: Sc in each Sc around.
Stuff head and neck. Do not continue to stuff.

## Body

Round 11: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times-12 sc.
Round 12: Sc in each sc around.
Round 13: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 4 times-16 sc.
Round 14: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 4 times-20 sc.
Rounds 15 and 16: Sc in each sc around.
Round 17: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc ] 4 times-24 sc.
Rounds 18-27: Sc in each Sc around.
Place two jingle bells inside Easter egg. Insert egg into body.
Round 28: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times-18 sc.
Round 29: [Sc2tog] 9 times- 9 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle, weave tail through stitches of last round. Pull gently, but firmly, to close opening. Tie securely, and weave in end.

## MUZZLE

Beginning at center front of muzzle, with smaller hook, ch 2.
Round 1 (RS): Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn-4 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-8 sc.
Rounds 3 and 4: Sc in each Sc around.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff muzzle and sew to lower front of head.

## EAR (make 2)

With smaller hook, ch 5.
Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; rotate piece to work across opposite side of foundation ch (do not turn piece over, keep same side facing you), sc in next ch, hdc in last 2 ch -9 sts.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew one ear to each side of head, toward the back.

## ARMS (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with smaller hook, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn-6 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Rounds 2-4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times-8 sc.
Rounds 6-8: Sc in each sc around.
Stuff piece lightly.
Round 9: [Sc2tog] 4 times-4 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With yarn needle and long tail, sew one arm to each side of body, below neck.
LEGS (make 2)
Beginning at top of leg, with smaller hook, ch 2.
Round 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join and do not turn-8 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-16 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 4 times-20 sc.
Stuff piece lightly. Continue to stuff piece as work progresses.
Rounds 4-6: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 7: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-14 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 8: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 4 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-10 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 9: Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 2$ times- 8 sc .
Rounds 10 and 11: Sc in each sc around.
Round 12: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 2 times, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-10 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 13 and 14: Sc in each sc around.
Round 15: [Sc2tog] 5 times-5 sc.
Round 16: [Sc2tog] 2 times, sc in next sc-3 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a very long tail. With yarn needle, weave tail through stitches of last round. Pull gently, but
firmly, to close opening. Tie securely, do not cut tail, use tail to shape and sew one leg to each side of body, as
follows: Flatten top of leg (widest end) slightly and pin it to the side of the body, below the arm. Fold the leg slightly so the foot is positioned to the floor and tack the foot to the leg. Sew the leg to the body. With yarn needle and another length of yarn, sew 2 lines into each foot to form toes. Weave in ends.

## TAIL

Beginning at tip of tail, with smaller hook, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 5 sc in 2 nd ch from hook- 5 sc.
Place a marker to indicate the end of the round and move the marker up as each round is completed.
Rounds 2-8: Sc in each sc around.
Round 9: Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}-6 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 10-12: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff piece. With yarn needle, sew tail to bottom back, centered between legs. Weave in end.
FINISHING (Joey)
With yarn needle and brown yarn, using photograph as a guide, embroider straight st eyes on face, above muzzle. Embroider straight st mouth at end of muzzle. Embroider straight st nostrils on muzzle, above mouth. Weave in any remaining ends. Place Joey inside Mama's pouch.
