



MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/454 g, 812 yds/742 m):

Main Color (MC) Dark Pink (10621) **1 ball**

Contrast A Grass Green (10620) **1 ball**

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

MEASUREMENT

Approx 48" [122 cm] diameter

GAUGE

11 sc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Afghan is worked using Tapestry Crochet Techniques. To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw loop in next color through 2 loops on hook to complete st and proceed in next color.

Carry color not in use loosely across top of previous row and work color in use around it.

Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.

With MC, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.

1st rnd: Ch 3. 11 dc in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 12 dc.

2nd rnd: With MC, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. *With A, 2 dc in next dc. With MC, 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last dc. With A, 2 dc in last dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 6 groups of MC and 6 groups of A.

3rd rnd: With MC, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in next dc. *With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next dc. With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 2 dc. With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in last dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

4th rnd: With MC, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. *With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. With MC,

2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Rep from * to last 3 dc. With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Alternate colors as follows:

5th rnd: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. *With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * to last 4 dc. With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

6th rnd: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. PM. *With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. PM. With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. PM. Rep from * to last 5 dc. With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

7th rnd: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. *With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. With A, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. Rep from * to last marker. With MC, 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Cont in same manner, inc 12 sts every rnd as before and alternate colors every following 3rd rnd from previous color change until there are 5 groups of MC sections and 5 groups of A sections. 28 rnds in total have been worked.

Cont in color changing technique for 2 more rnds. Fasten off MC.

Next 4 rnds: With A only, ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. *2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to next marker.

Rep from * to last marker. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off A.

Next rnd: Join MC with sl st to first dc. Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. *2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to next marker. Rep from * to last marker. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of rnd. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Next rnd: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. (1 dc. 1 tr) in next dc. (1 tr. 1 dc) in next dc. 1 sc in next dc. *1 sc in next dc. (1 dc. 1 tr) in next dc. (1 tr. 1 dc) in next dc. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
