



 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 42" x 49" [106.5 x 124.5 cm]

GAUGE

13 dc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Motif (make 42)

Chain (Ch) 25.

1st row: [Right side (RS)]. 1 double crochet (dc) in 4th ch from hook and each chain (ch) to end of chain. Turn. 23 dc.

2nd row: Chain (ch) 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

Repeat (Rep) last row until work from beginning (beg) measures 7" [18 cm].

Fasten off.

Sew Motifs together (tog) in parquetry pattern (alternating stripe directions as shown in photo): 6 Motifs wide x 7 Motifs long.

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® Stripes™ (4 oz/113 g; 194 yds/177 m)
Churchill Downs (14004) **8 balls**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Approx = Approximately

Dc = Double crochet

Tog = Together

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Ch = Chain(s)

RS = Right side
