COUNTRY TWEED CROCHET AFGHAN | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (454 g/16. oz;742 m/812 yds)

Contrast A Espresso (10581) 2 balls Contrast B Taupe (10511) 1 balls Contrast C Soft Sage (10580) 1 balls

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.



CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly) Rnd(s) = Round(s)**Beg** = Beginning **Sc** = Single crochet Ch = Chain(s) $\mathbf{sk} = \mathbf{skip}$ Dc = Double crochet**SI st** = Slip stitch Sp(s) = Space(s)**Rep** = Repeat

MEASUREMENTS

RS = Right side

Approx 50 x 64"[127 x 162.5 cm]

GAUGE

12 sts and 10 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in pat

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed, keeping color change to WS of work.

Carry color not in use along side edge of work.

Ch 3 at beg of work counts as dc.

With A, ch 141.

1st row: (RS) 1 dc in 4th ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 139 dc.

2nd row: Ch 3. *2 dc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Join B. Turn. 116 dc. 3rd row: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 dc. *Working in front of next ch-1 sp, dc3tog over 3 skipped sts 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 5 dc. Rep from *, ending with: 1 sc in each of last 3 dc. Turn.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

4th row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in next dc3tog. *2 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next 3 sc. 2 dc in next sc. 1 dc in next dc3tog. Rep from * to last 3 sc. 1 dc in each of last 3 dc. Join C. Turn.

5th row: With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 6 dc. *Working in front of next ch-1 sp, dc3tog over 3 skipped sts 2 rows below. 1 sc in each of next 5 dc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 sc in last dc. Turn.



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6th row: Ch 3. 2 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next 3 sc. 2 dc in next sc. *1 dc in next dc3tog. 2 dc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next 3 sc. 2 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 dc in last sc. Join A. Turn. 7th and 8th rows: With A, as 3rd and 4th rows.

9th and 10th rows: With B, as 5th and 6th rows.

11th and 12th rows: With C, as 3rd and 4th rows.

13th and 14th rows: With A, as 5th and 6th rows.

Rep 3rd to 14th rows 11 times more, then 3rd to 7th rows once. **Next row:** With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Pin Afghan to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.

Border: With RS facing, join A with sl st to any corner.

Note: Amount of sc between corner groups of 3 sc needs to be multiply of 3.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 3 sc in same sp as sl st. Work in sc around entire edge of Afghan, having 3 sc in corners. Join with sl st to first sc.

2nd rnd: SI st in next sc (center sc of corner group of 3 sc). Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1). [(1 dc. Ch 1) twice. 1 dc] all in same sp as last sI st. **Skip next 2 sc. *(1 dc. Ch 1. 1 dc) in next sc. Skip next 2 sc.* Rep from * to * to next corner sc. [(1 dc. Ch 1) 3 times. 1 dc] all in next corner sc. Rep from ** twice more. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to * to end of rnd. Join with sI st to 3rd ch of ch 4.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. *(1 sc. Ch 3. 1 sc) in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
