Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Tea Cakes ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $8.5 \mathrm{oz} / 240 \mathrm{~g} ; 204 \mathrm{yds} / 186 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Underbrush (20055) 7 cakes
Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48 " x 55½" [122 x 141 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGES

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].
9.5 sts and 5 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Triangle Lace Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Triangle Lace

Note: Worked over foundation ch multiple of $6 \mathrm{ch}+14$.

Ch 116.
1st row: (WS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (counts as 2 hdc). *Ch 3. Skip next 3 ch .1 hdc in next ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 hdc in next ch. Rep from * to last 5 ch. Ch 3. Skip next 3 ch .1 hdc in each of last 2 ch . Turn. 115 sts.
2nd row: (RS). Ch 1.1 sc in first hdc. *Ch 2. Skip next hdc. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2 . Skip next hdc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last ch-3 sp. Ch 2 . Skip next hdc. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Ch 2. Skip next hdc. 1 sc in top of last hdc (beg ch-2). Turn.

## CRO․ STACKING TRIANGLES LACY CROCHET BLANKET

3rd row: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dtr. Ch 1). Skip next ch-2 sp. *1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 3. Skip next (Ch-2. 1 sc . Ch-2). Rep from * to last 3-dc group. 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1. 1 dtr in last sc. Turn.
4th row: Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc ). 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. *Ch 2 . Skip next hdc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 2 . Skip next hdc. 3 dc in next ch-3 sp. Rep from * to last 2 hdc. Ch 2. Skip next hdc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 2. Skip next hdc. 2 dc in next ch- 5 sp . Turn. 5th row: Ch 2 (counts as 1 hdc). 1 hdc in next dc. *Ch 3. Skip next (Ch-2. $1 \mathrm{sc} . \mathrm{Ch}-2$ ). 1 hdc in next dc. Ch 1 . Skip next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. Rep from * to last sc. Ch 3. Skip next (Ch-2. 1 sc. Ch-2). 1 hdc in next dc. 1 hdc in top of last dc (beg ch-3). Turn.
Rep 2nd to 5th rows for Triangle Lace Pat until work from beg measures $471 / 2$ " $[120.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$. Do not fasten off. Turn.

Top Edging: 1 st row: (RS). ${ }^{* *}$ Ch 1. Work 84 sc evenly across top edge of Blanket. Turn. 84 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until Top Edging measures 4" [10 cm], ending on a WS row.
Fasten off.**
Bottom Edging: (RS). Join yarn with sl st to corner of Blanket to work across bottom edge. Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as for Top Edging across bottom edge of Blanket.

Fringe: Cut lengths of yarn 10" [ 25.5 cm ] long. Taking 3 strands tog, knot into fringe in every other st along top and bottom edges of Blanket (as shown in photo). Trim fringe evenly.
