



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

MEASUREMENT

Approx 55" [139.5 cm] square.

GAUGES

14 scbl and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

Square = Approx 13¾" [35 cm] square.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, 34 rows.

With B, 14 rows

These 48 rows complete Stripe Pat.

SQUARE (make 16)

With A, ch 2.

1st row: (RS). 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in first sc. 3 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in last sc. Turn. 5 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 2 sc. 3 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of last 2 sc. Turn. 7 sc.

4th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 3 sc. 3 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of last 3 sc. Turn. 9 sc.

MATERIALS

Caron® Crystal Cakes™ (8.5 oz/240 g; 634 yds/580 m)

Contrast A Peacock (17002) **2 balls or 1268 yds/1160 m**

Contrast B Shea Butter (17010) **3 balls or 1448 yds/1324 m**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 scbl in each of first 4 sc. 3 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of last 4 sc. Turn. 11 sc.

First 5 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Cont in same manner, having 2 more sc in center of every row until 48 rows are complete. 97 sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Squares tog as shown in Assembly Diagram.
