### **MATERIALS**

**Caron**® **Lava Cakes**™ (8.5 oz/240 g; 457 yds/418 m)

Palomino Teal (66040)

4 cakes

Size U.S. K10½ [6.5 mm] crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.





### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approx = Rep = RepeatSp(s) = Space(s)**St(s)** = Stitch(es) **Approximately** Rnd(s) = Round(s)Ch = Chain(s)**RS** = Right side **Tog** = Together **Dc** = Double crochet **Sc** = Single crochet **WS** = Wrong side **Rem** = Remaining **SI st** = Slip stitch

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 50" x 56" [127 x 142 cm]

### GAUGE

11 dc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm].

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Notes:**

- · You will be working from both ends of the cake.
- Solid (outer) shade of cake will be referred to as Contrast A.
- Inner variegated shade will be referred to as Contrast B.
- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.
- Blanket is worked with 6 horizontal Panels.

Panel (make 6) With A, ch 136.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc into 3rd ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 134 dc. **2nd row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next

43 dc. With B, 1 dc in each of last 90 dc. Turn.

3rd row: With B, ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 89 dc. With A. 1 dc in each of last 44 dc. Turn.

4th and 5th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows once more.

6th row: With A, ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

7th row: As 3rd row. 8th row: As 2nd row.

9th and 10th rows: Rep 7th and

8th rows once more. 11th row: As 6th row. 12th row: As 2nd row.



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**13th row:** As 3rd row.


**14th and 15th row:** Rep 12th and 13th rows once more.

16th row: As 6th row. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Arrange 6 Panels tog alternating RS facing and WS facing.

Join Panels: 1st row: (WS). Join A with sl st to top right corner. Working through both thicknesses of back loops only, 1 sc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off. Join rem Panels in same way.



**Edging:** With RS of joining seams facing, join B with sl st to top right corner of Panel 6.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. \*Ch 1. Skip next dc. 1 sc.\* Rep from \* to \* across Panel 6. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) into top of last dc of Panel 6. Turn to work along left side of Panels. \*\*(Ch 1. 1 sc) into side of dc post.\*\* Rep from \*\* to \*\* to last st of Panel 1. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in top of last st of Panel 1. Turn to work along Panel 1. Rep from \* to \* across Panel 1 to last st of Panel 1. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) into top of last st of Panel 1. Turn to work along Right side of Panels. Rep from \*\* to \*\* to end of rnd. Join with sl st to first sc. 376 sts: 188 sc and 188 ch. 2nd and 3rd rnds: SI st in corner ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 2 sc in same sp as sl st. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \* around, working (Ch 1. 1 sc) twice in corner ch-1 sps. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
