CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**Sp(s)** = Space(s)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 27" x 30" [68.5 x 76 cm]

### GAUGE

20 rows and 20 sts = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Stripe Pat

(MC - 1 row. Red - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Pink - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Orange - 2 rows)

4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Lemon Yellow - 2 rows)

4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Soft Green - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Kelly Green - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Mint Green - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Light Blue - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Light Purple - 2 rows) 4 times.

(MC - 1 row. Dark Purple - 2 rows) 4 times.

These 132 rows form Stripe Pat.

### MATERIALS

**Caron® Simply Soft®** (6 oz / 170.1 g; 315 yds / 288 m)

**Main Color (MC)** White (39701) **2 balls**

**Caron® Little Crafties™** (20 g/0.7 oz, 58 m/63 yds per shade x 20 shades)

**Contrast A** Red, Pink, Orange, Lemon Yellow, Soft Green, Kelly Green, Mint Green, Light Blue, Dark Blue, Light Purple, Dark Purple

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Yarn needle.

**Tip from designer:** Each section is 2 rows of Contrast Color separated by 1 row of MC for a total of 8 rows of Contrast Color and 4 rows of MC

**Notes:**

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.
- Carry color not in use across top edge of work and work sts over yarn not in use.
- Blanket is reversible. There is no RS or WS.

**Note from designer:** If you want blanket wider with the same Stripe Pat, use any EVEN number of chains, but no more than Ch 134. For wider blanket, to use 1 ball of each Contrast Color, work Stripe pat: (MC - 1 row. Contrast Color - 2 rows) 3 times. In this case colored sections will be shorter.

With MC, ch 126.

**1st row:** 1 sc in 4th chain from hook. \*Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of chain. Join Red. Turn. 125 sts (sc and ch-1).

**2nd and 3rd rows:** With Red, ch 2. 1 sc in first ch-1 sp. \*Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from \*, ending with 1 sc in sp between turning ch-2 and sc from the previous row. Join MC. Turn.

First 3 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Keeping cont of Stripe pat, rep 2nd row of Moss st until 132 rows of Stripe Pat will be complete.

**Border**

**1st rnd:** Join MC with sl st to first sc. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in same sp as sl st. \*Work Moss St across last row to next corner. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in corner.\* Work Moss Stitch down side of Blanket as follows: \*\*1 sc at the end of a row. Ch 1. Skip one row. 1 sc in end of next row.\*\* Rep from \*\* to\*\* to next corner. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in corner. Work from \* to \* to next corner. Rep from \*\* to\*\* to next corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Turn.

**2nd to 6th rnds:** Ch 1. Work Moss Sitch around, having (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in corner ch-1 sps. Join with sl st to first sc. Turn. Fasten off at end of last rnd.
