



## MATERIALS

**Caron® Spice Cakes™** (8 oz/227 g; 239 yds/218 m)

Indigo-go (27010)

**5 balls**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
7" [18 cm] piece of cardboard for tassels. Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 48" [122 cm] square  
excluding tassels.

## GAUGE

11 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in  
sc/ch-1 pat

## INSTRUCTIONS

With A, ch 3.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 sc in 3rd ch from  
hook (counts as 1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc).  
Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. Skip first sc. (1 sc.  
Ch 1. 1 sc) in ch-1 sp. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 3. Skip first sc. 1 sc in  
next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc)  
in last ch-3 sp. Turn.

**4th row:** Ch 3. Skip first sc. \*1 sc  
in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc.  
Rep from \* to last ch-3 sp. (1 sc.  
Ch 1. 1 sc) in last ch-3 sp. Turn.

Rep 4th row until side edge from  
beg measures 48" [122 cm], ending on  
a WS row.

Dec as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). Ch 2. Skip first sc.  
\*1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip  
next sc. Rep from \* to last ch-1 sp.  
1 sc in last ch-1 sp. Skip next sc.  
1 sc in last ch-2 sp. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Skip first 2 sc. \*1 sc  
in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc.  
Rep from \* to last ch-1 sp. 1 sc in  
last ch-1 sp. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last  
ch-2 sp. Turn.

Rep 2nd row until 3 sc rem.

**Next row:** (RS). Ch 2. Skip first 2 sc.  
1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Skip next sc.  
1 sc in last ch-2 sp. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch 1. Skip first 2 sc. 1 sc  
in last ch-2 sp. Fasten off.

**Tassels:** (Make 4). Wrap yarn around a 7" [18 cm] piece of cardboard 30 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn 6 times around tassel 1½" [4 cm] from tied end, and fasten securely. Attach Tassels to each corner of Blanket.
