MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Contrast A White (10501) 2 balls **Contrast B** Royalty (10530) 1 ball

Contrast C Aqua (10622) 1 ball

Contrast D Ocean (10611) 1 ball

Contrast E Off White (10514) 1 ball

Size U.S. J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch = Chain(s)

= Working in front of chain spaces; work 1 dc in each of 2 skipped sc 3 rows

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 59½" [132 x 151 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGE

11 sts and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Mosaic Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To change colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of previous stitch and draw new color through.
- When working Mosaic Pat, carry color not in use loosely up side of work unless otherwise stated.

- Each pair of skipped sc has ch-3 worked above it for 2 rows. This establishes the 'gap' where 2 Mosaic Dc will later be worked
- Mosaic Dc always replaces sc directly behind it on working row
- WS of your work maintains alternating 2-row striped pattern because you are working in front of chain spaces each time you work Mosaic Dc - you are never working around chain-spaces. The chain-spaces sit behind Mosaic Dc.



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- On RS rows when working into a st that is a different color than current working color, work sts into back loops only. If st you are working into is same color, work under both loops as usual.
- Blanket is worked lengthwise, from side to side.

BLANKET

With A, ch 163 (multiple of 8 ch + 11).

Set-up row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 162 sc.

Proceed with First Mosaic Stripe (See Chart on page 4) where Color 1 is A and Color 2 is B as follows:

1st row: (RS). With Color 1, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. **2nd row: (WS). With Color 1, ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

3rd row: With Color 2, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Working in BLO, (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to last 8 sts. Working in BLO, (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. Turn.

4th row: With Color 2, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 4 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. *Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

5th row: With Color 1, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *[Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice] twice. Rep from * to last 8 sc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

6th row: With Color 1, ch 1, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3 *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

7th row: With Color 2, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *(Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to last 8 sts. *(Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

8th row: With Color 2, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 8 sts. *Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

9th row: With Color 1, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Rep from * to last 8 sts. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

10th row: With Color 1, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 2 sts. *Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

11th row: With Color 2, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *(Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Rep from * to last 8 sts. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Turn.

12th row: With Color 2, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 4 sc. Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. *Ch 3. Skip next ch-3. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. Turn. Join new Color 1 (as below). **Break Color 2.****

Proceed with Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is C and Color 2 is A as follows:

1st row: (RS). With Color 1, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, (Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Working in BLO, (Mosaic Dc) twice. Rep from * to last 8 sts. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. Working in BLO, (Mosaic Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. Turn.



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2nd to 12th rows: Rep from ** to ** as given for First Mosaic Stripe. These 12 rows form Mosaic Stripe Pat.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is D and Color 2 is C.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is E and Color 2 is D.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is B and Color 2 is E.

*** Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is A and Color 2 is B.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is C and Color 2 is A.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat **Fringe:** Cut lengths of A 14" where Color 1 is D and Color 2 is C. [35.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is E and Color 2 is D.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is B and Color 2 is E.***

Rep from *** to *** once more.

Work 12 rows of Mosaic Stripe Pat where Color 1 is A and Color 2 is B.

Next row: (RS). With A, ch 1. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of first 2 sc. *Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. (Mosaic Dc) twice. Rep from * to last 8 sts. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. (Mosiac Dc) twice. Working in BLO, 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. Fasten off.

Edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join A with sl st to any corner of Blanket. Ch 1. Work sc evenly around Blanket, working around yarn carried loosely up side of work to enclose it, and working (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc) in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut lengths of A 14" [35.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands tog, knot into fringe in every other st along top and bottom edges of Blanket (as shown in photo). Trim fringe evenly.









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How to read Mosaic Chart:

- Each square of chart represents 1 stitch.
- RS rows (odd numbered rows) are read from right to left. WS rows (even numbered rows) are read from left to right.
- · Each row is worked in one color only. First stitch of chart indicates the color to be used in that row.
- When a contrast color appears (eq: 2 white squares in a gray row) work as "ch 3. Skip next 2 sts".
- On RS rows when working into a st that is a different color than current working color, work sts into back loops only. If working into st of same color, work under both loops as usual.
- On RS rows when a ch-3 sp appears, work 1 Mosaic Dc into each of 2 skipped sts 3 rows below.
