

MATERIALS

Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet
Lp st = Loop stitch = Insert hook
in next stitch. Wrap working yarn over top of index finger, from front to back, to form 1" [2.5 cm ] loop. Placing tip of hook behind yarn at front of index finger, Yoh and draw up a loop onto hook. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook, dropping loop off index finger to back of work (see diagram). Loop will be formed on opposite side of work. After working RS rows, pull loops formed on WS through fabric to RS of work.

Pat $=$ Pattern
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ One Pound ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $16 \mathrm{oz} / 453.6 \mathrm{~g} ; 812 \mathrm{yds} / 742 \mathrm{~m}$ ) <br> Main Color (MC) Off-White (10514) 3 balls <br> Contrast A Aqua (10622) 1 ball <br> Contrast B Dark Pink (10621) 1 ball <br> Contrast C Sunflower (10549) 1 ball



## MEASUREMENTS

Approx $51 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56^{\prime \prime}[131 \times 142 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

12 sts and 11 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Tuft Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as 1 dc .
- Ch 1 at beg of row does not count as st.
- To join new color, work to last 2 loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color, draw through rem loops and proceed with new color.
- When working with 2 colors in a row, carry color when not in use loosely across top of last row and work sts around it to enclose it, being sure to maintain gauge.


## BLANKET

With MC, ch 157 (multiple of 16 ch $+13)$.
Set-up 1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4 th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc ). 1 dc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 155 sts. Set-up 2nd row: Ch 3.1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

Proceed in Tuft Pat where Color 1 is $A$ and Color 2 is $B$, noting 1st row is RS , as follows:
1st to 6th rows: With MC, ch 1.1 sc in each of first 2 sts. *With Color 1 , Lp st in each of next 7 sts. With MC, 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * to last 9 sts. With Color 1, Lp st in each of next 7 sts. With MC, 1 sc in each of last 2 sts. Turn.
Note: Pull loops formed on WS in 1st, 3rd and 5th rows towards RS of Blanket.
Break Color 1.
7th and 8th rows: With MC, ch 3. 1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn. 9th to 14th rows: With MC, ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 10 sts. *With Color 2, Lp st in each of next 7 sts. With MC, 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * to last st. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

Note: Pull loops formed on WS in 9th, 11th and 13th rows towards RS of Blanket.
Break Color 2.
15th and 16th rows: With MC, ch 3.1 dc in each st to end of row. Turn
17th to 24th rows: Rep 1st to 8th rows in Tuft Pat where Color 1 is C .

25th to 32nd row: Rep 9th to 16th rows in Tuft Pat where Color 2 is A. 33rd to 40th rows: Rep 1st to 8th rows in Tuft Pat where Color 1 is B. 41st to 48th rows: Rep 9th to 16th rows in Tuft Pat where Color 2 is C . Last 48 rows form Tuft Pat.

Cont in Tuft Pat until work from beg measures approx 56 " [142 cm], ending on an 8th row of pat. Fasten off.

Reduced Sample of Pattern

- Each square/rectangle of chart represents 1 stitch,
noting first ch- 3 of 7 th, 8 th, 15 th and 16 th rows of
Tuft Pat counts as first st.
- Loops will be formed on opposite side of work.
After working RS rows, pull loops formed on WS
through fabric to RS of work.
- RS rows (odd numbered rows) are read from right
to left. WS rows (even numbered rows) are read
from left to right.
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
