MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 59" [127 x 150 cm].

GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

BLANKET

SMALL MOTIF (make 20 each with A as Color 1, B as Color 1, and C as Color 1):

With Color 1, ch 2.

See Diagram on page 3.

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Do not join in rnd. Place a marker on last st to mark end of rnd. Cont moving this marker at end of each subsequent rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 scbl in each sc around. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in next sc. Rep from * around. 18 sc.

4th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. 24 sc.

5th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. 30 sc.

6th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * around. 36 sc. Join MC with sl st to first sc. Break Color 1.

MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/454 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Main Color (MC) Off White (10514) **3 balls or 1815 yds/1660 m**

Contrast A Dark Pink (10621) **1 ball or 420 yds/384 m**

Contrast B Sunflower (10549) **1 ball or 420 yds/384 m**

Contrast C Aqua (10622) **1 ball or 420 yds/384 m**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle. Susan Bates® stitch markers.

7th rnd: With MC, ch 1. *Working in **both loops**, 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc. 2 dc in next sc. 3 tr in next sc. 2 dc in next sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

8th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 5 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 3 dc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

LARGE MOTIF (make 5 with A as Color 1, make 5 with B as Color 1, and make 5 with C as Color 1):

See Diagram on page 3.

Work 1st to 5th rnds as given for Small Motif.

6th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * around. 36 sc.

7th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * around. 42 sc.

8th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 6 sc. Rep from * around. 48 sc.

9th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 7 sc. Rep from * around. 54 sc.

10th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 8 sc. Rep from * around. 60 sc.

11th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 9 sc. Rep from * around. 66 sc.

12th rnd: *2 scbl in next sc. 1 scbl in each of next 10 sc. Rep from * around. Join MC with sl st to first sc. 72 sc. Break Color 1.

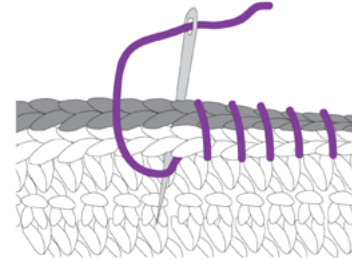
13th rnd: With MC, ch 1. *Working in **back loops only**, 1 scbl in each of next 4 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 sc. 2 dc in next sc. 3 tr in next sc. 2 dc in next sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

14th rnd: Ch 1. *Working in **both loops**, 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 3 dc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 8 sts. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

15th rnd: Ch 1. *Working in **both loops**, 1 sc in each of next 12 sts. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc.

16th rnd: Ch 1. Working in **both loops**, 1 sc in each sc around, working 5 sc in center sc of each 3-sc corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

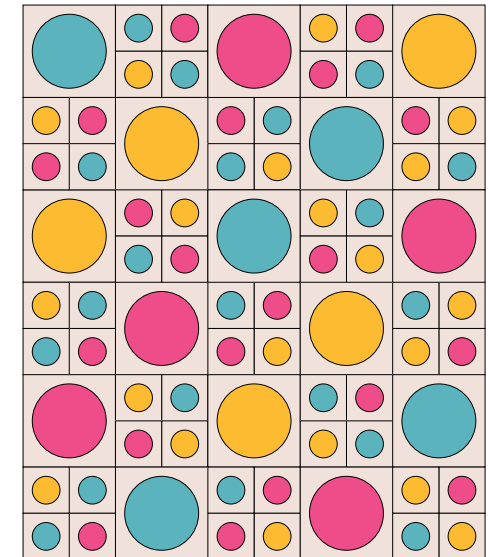
Sew Motifs using Whipstitch tog as shown in Assembly Diagram.



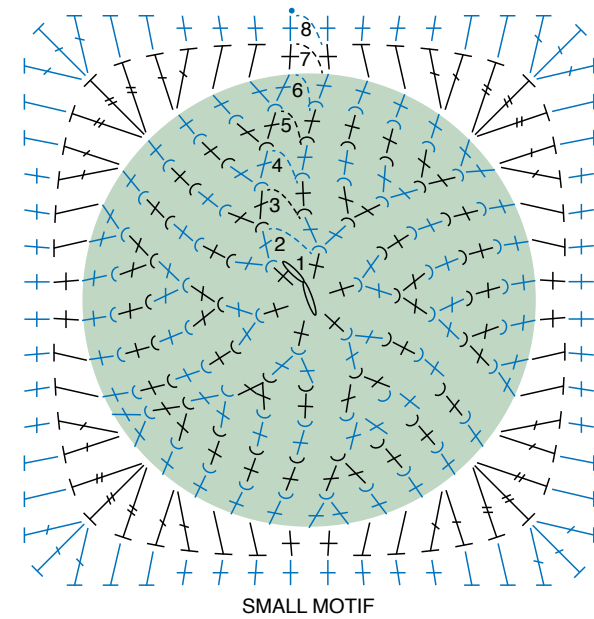
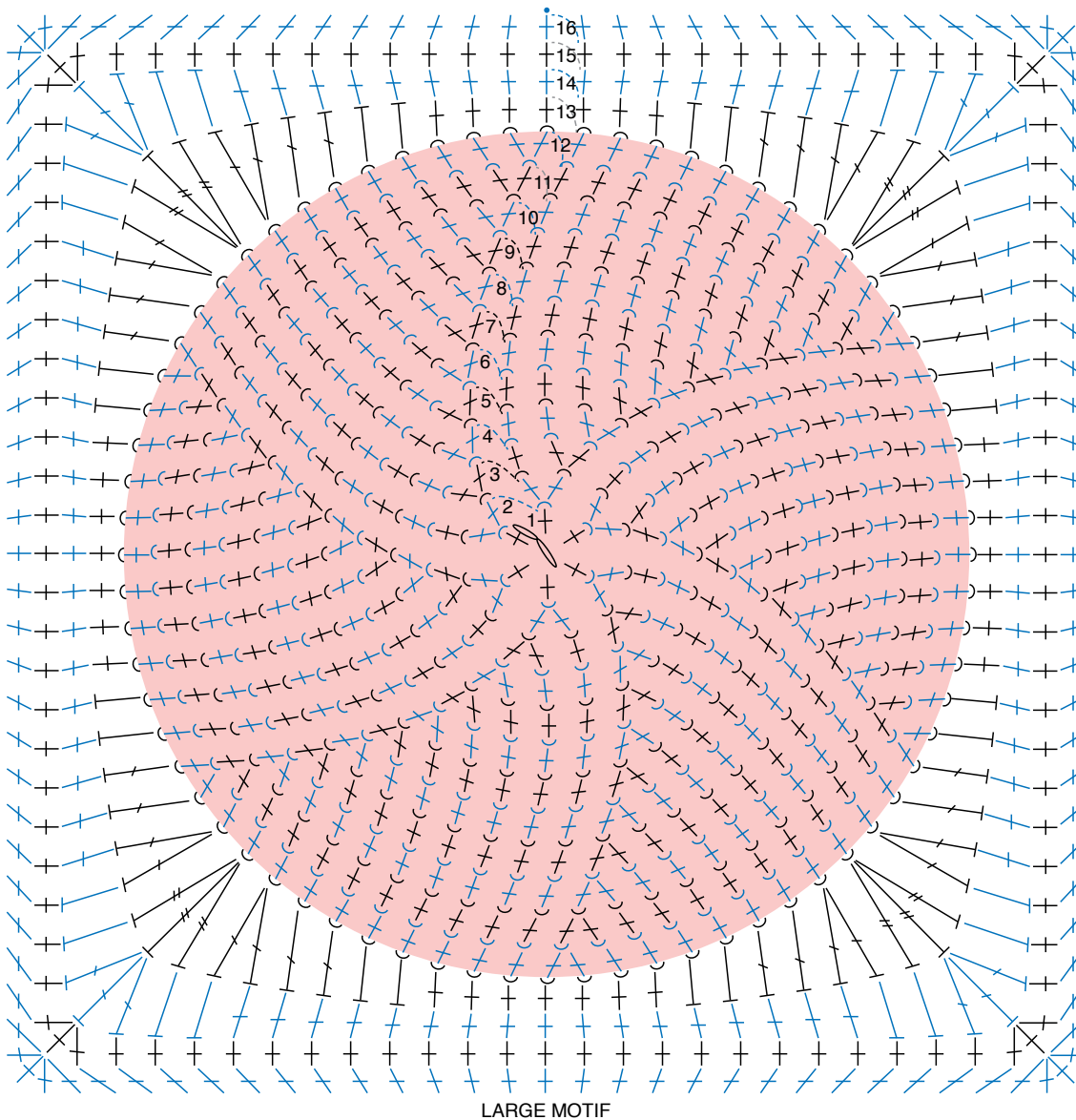
WHIPSTITCH



Edging: With RS of work facing, join MC with sl st to any corner sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 4 dc in same sp as sl st. Work dc evenly around, having 5 dc in each corner. Join with sl st to first dc. Fasten off.
