

MATERIALS
Caron ${ }^{\oplus}$ Marble Cakes ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $8.5 \mathrm{oz} / 240 \mathrm{~g} ; 404 \mathrm{yds} / 369 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Violet Plum (21006)

## 2 balls

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
(9. 4 MEDUM CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) $=$ Round(s)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" [ 25.5 cm ] diameter x 10 " [ 25.5 cm ] tall.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 12 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ with
2 strands tog.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Basket is worked holding 2 strands of yarn tog throughout. It is not necessary to match colors of 2 balls, as desired marled effect is achieved by blending colors between balls.
- Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

With 2 strands held tog, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc .
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
$\mathbf{S I} \mathbf{s t}=$ Slip stitch
St(s) $=$ Stitch(es)
Tog = Together

3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 30 sc.

6th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 36 sc.

7th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 5 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 42 sc .

8th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 48 sc.

9th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 7 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 54 sc.

10th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 8 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 60 sc.

11th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 9 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 66 sc.

12th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 10 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 72 sc.

13th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 11 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 78 sc.

14th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 12 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 84 sc .

15th rnd: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 13 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 90 sc.

16th rnd: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.
17th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join.
18th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 sc in last dc. Join.

19th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join.
Rep last 2 rnds until work from base measures 8 " [ 20.5 cm ].

Next rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
Rep last rnd until work from base measures 10 " $[25.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

Next rnd: Ch 1. Working from left to right instead of from right to left as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.
