## CROB ANGLED STRIPES KNIT SHAWL



MATERIALS
Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)
Contrast A Ocean (39759)
1 ball
Contrast B Cobalt Blue (39784) 1 ball
Contrast C Robin's Egg (39780) 1 ball
Size U.S. 9 ( 5.5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ steel yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ split-lock stitch count markers.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Alt $=$ Alternate
Beg $=$ Beginning
Center Dec = (worked over 3 sts)
Slip next 2 stitches as if to K2tog.
K1, then pass slipped sts over knit st - center of 3 sts should be on top of decrease, 2 sts have been decreased
Cont $=$ Continue(ity)
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 29" [73.5 cm] deep x 62" [157.5 cm ] long.

## GAUGE

17 sts and 34 rows $=4$ " 10 cm ] in garter st

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Stripe Pat

With B, knit 32 rows.
With C, knit 32 rows.
With A, knit 32 rows.
These 96 rows Stripe Pat.
$\mathbf{K f b}=$ Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch
Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep = Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
SI1Pwyif = Slip next stitch
purlwise with yarn in front of work
$\mathbf{S t}(\mathbf{s})=$ Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

## SHAWL

Note: Move marker up each row on marked st.

With A, cast on 1 st.
1st row: (RS). (K1. yo. K1) all in stitch. 3 sts.
2nd row: K1. P1. K1.
3rd row: Kfb. K1. Kfb. 5 sts.
4th row: Kfb. K1. SI1Pwyif. Kfb. K1. 7 sts.
5th row: Kfb. K1. Center dec. PM on last st. Kfb. K1. 7 sts.

## C8O ANGLED STRIPES KNIT SHAWL

6th row: K3. SI1Pwyif (marked st). K3.
7th row: Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 8 sts.
8th row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 10 sts.
9th row: Kfb. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 10 sts. 10th row: Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.

Rep 7th to 10th rows until 62 rows with $A$ are complete.
Start working in Stripe Pat until work across center decrease line measures approx $34^{\prime \prime}[86.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on 10th row.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat proceed as follows:
Next row: (RS). K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
Next row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. Sl1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.
Next row: K2tog. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.
Next row: Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Rep last 4 rows, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until all sts before center decrease line will be cast off, ending on a WS row.
Cast off rem sts (WS).
