# CARON<sup>®</sup> KNIT IT TONIGHT COWL | KNIT



#### MATERIALS

**Caron® Simply Soft™** (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m) Ocean (9759) **1 ball** 

Cowl is made using 2 strands of yarn held together throughout. One skein will make a cowl by working with both ends of the skein at the same time; or use 2 skeins and make 2 cowls. One circular needle size U.S. 11 (8mm), 16"/40.5 cm long, **or size to obtain gauge**. Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

Approx = Approximate(ly) BO = Bind off CO = Cast on K = Knit P = Purl

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 25" [63.5 cm] circumference, 11" [28 cm long].

#### GAUGE

In Diagonal Rib, 12 sts and 18 rows = 4"/10 cm.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **STITCHES USED**

**Diagonal Rib** (multiple of 4 sts): **Rnds 1 and 2:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 3 and 4:** \*P1, k2, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 5 and 6:** \*P2, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnds 7 and 8:** \*K1, p2, k1; rep from \* around.

Repeat Rnds 1-8 for Diagonal Rib.

**Rep** = Repeat **Rnd(s)** = Round(s) **St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## COWL

Holding 2 strands of yarn together, CO 76 sts. Join to work in the rnd, taking care not to twist sts; place marker at beginning of rnd. **Rnds 1-48:** Repeat Rnds 1-8 of Diagonal Rib 6 times. **Rnd 49:** Repeat Rnd 1 of Diagonal Rib. BO all sts loosely in pattern.

#### FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in ends.
