



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 14" [35.5 cm] deep x 25" [63.5 cm] around.

GAUGE

18 stitches (sts) and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 63 stitches (sts).

1st row: (Wrong side – WS). Knit.

**Work in garter stitch (st), (knit every row) for 10 rows (5 ridges).

Next row: (Right side – RS). Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Last 2 rows form Stocking stitch (Stocking st).

Repeat (Rep) last 2 rows of stocking st 4 times more. (10 rows of stocking st total).**

Rep from ** to ** until work from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 25" [63.5 cm]. Cast off.

Sew cast on and cast off edges together (tog).

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Burgundy (9762)

1 ball

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Approx = Approximately

Rep = Repeat

Tog = Together

Beg = Beginning

RS = Right side

WS = Wrong side

Pat = Pattern

St(s) = Stitch(es)
