MATERIALS

Caron[®] **x Pantone**[™] (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Purple Pops (01017) **1 braid** Strawberry Chill (01019) **1 braid**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 28" [71 cm] around x 15" [38 cm] deep.


GAUGE

14 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multishade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.



 Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).

 Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.

With Color 1 (beg at far left, as indicated in Materials section), cast on 72 sts. PM. Join to beg working in rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

1st rnd: *K1. Sl1Pwyif. yo. Rep from * around.

2nd rnd: With Color 2 (shown directly below Color 1), *Sl1Pwyif. yo. P2tog (slipped st and yo). Rep from * around. Drop Color 2, Pick up Color 1.

3rd rnd: With Color 1, *K2tog (slipped st and yo). Sl1Pwyif. yo. Rep from * around. Drop Color 1, Pick up Color 2.

Using same pair of Colors, rep last 2 rnds 8 times more for pat. Break both Color 1 and 2.

Keeping cont of pat, rep these 2 rnds using next pair of Color 1 and Color 2 shades (as shown on page 1) to last pairing, ending on a 2nd rnd. Break Color 2.

Next rnd: With Color 1, *K2tog (slipped st and yo). K1. Rep from * around.

Cast off knitwise
