MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Lollypop Whirl (01043)

River Rock (01010)

Frozen Berry (01022)

1 braid

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 11" [28 cm] deep x 27" [68.5 cm] around.


GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone # (see ball band).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D, E, etc as noted with Materials (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.
- Cowl is knit in the rnd and seamed tog to create a double thickness tubular Cowl.

With A, work 3 rnds.

With B, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With C, work 3 rnds.

With B, work 3 rnds.

With E, work 3 rnds.

With D, work 3 rnds.

With F, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With H, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With I, work 3 rnds.

With I, work 3 rnds.

With J, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With K, work 3 rnds.

With J, work 3 rnds.

With K, work 3 rnds.

With L, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With M, work 3 rnds.

With L, work 3 rnds.

With M, work 3 rnds.

With N, work 3 rnds.

Rep last 6 rnds once more.

With O, work 3 rnds.

With N, work 3 rnds.

With O, work 3 rnds.

With A, work 3 rnds.

With O, work 2 rnds.

These 134 rnds from Stripe Pat.

Version 2

Work 9 rnds in each shade in this sequence:

A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N. With O, work 8 rnds.


These 134 rnds form Stripe Pat.

Both Versions:

With A, cast on 83 sts. Join in rnd, being careful not to twist. Place marker on first st to mark beg of rnd. Proceed in Stripe Pat (Version 1 or Version 2), knit in rnds until 134 rnds of Stripe Pat is complete. With O, cast off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. With O, sew cast on and cast off edges tog using the invisible seaming method as shown in diagram, working around entire circumference to form double thickness Cowl.
