



MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz /100 g; 127 yds/116 m)
 Fuchsia Foliage (01020) **1 braid for all sizes**

Set of 4 sizes U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

SIZES

To fit **2/4 yrs (8/10 yrs - Adult)**

GAUGE

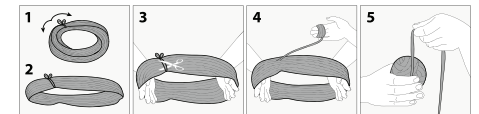
15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Notes:

- Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone #
- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results

RIGHT MITTEN

With set of smaller double-pointed needles and A, cast on **20 (26-30) sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles **7, 7, 6 (9, 9, 8-10, 10, 10)**. Join in rnd, PM on first st.

1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around. Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing for **1½ (2½-2½)" [4 (5.5-5.5) cm]**. Break A.

With C and larger needles, knit **2 (4-6)** rnds.**

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K**10 (13-15)**. (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd. **22 (28-32)** sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit. **3rd rnd:** K**10 (13-15)**. Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. **24 (30-34)** sts.

Sizes 8/10 and Adult only: **5th rnd:** K(**13-15**). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. (**32-36**) sts. **6th rnd:** Knit.

Size Adult only: 7th rnd: K15. Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 38 sts. **8th rnd:** Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K**16 (21-25)**. Slip last **6 (8-10)** sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd. Break C.

Next rnd: With D, knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. **20 (26-30)** sts.

***With D, knit 3 rnds. Break D. With E, knit in rnds until work after ribbing measures **3½ (5-6)" [9 (12.5-15) cm]**.

Rearrange sts as follows: 10 (13-15) sts on 1st needle. **5 (6-7)** sts on 2nd needle and **5 (7-8)** sts on 3rd needle.

Shape top: 1st rnd: 1st needle: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. **2nd needle:** K1. ssk. Knit to end of needle. **3rd needle:** Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd rnd: Knit. Rep last 2 rnds until **8 (10-10)** sts rem. Break E, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem **8 (10-10)** sts. Draw up and fasten securely.

Thumb: With B, K**6 (8-10)** from safety pin. Pick up and knit 2 sts at base of thumb. Divide these **8 (10-12)** sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. Knit **6 (8-10)** rnds even.

Next rnd: (K2tog) **4 (5-6)** times. Break yarn leaving a long end. Thread end through rem **4 (5-6)** sts. Draw up and fasten securely.***

LEFT MITTEN

Work from ** to ** as given for Right Mitten, substituting B for A, D for C.

Proceed as follows:

Shape thumb gusset: 1st rnd: K**8 (11-13)**. (Kfb) twice. Knit to end of rnd.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit. **3rd rnd:** K**8 (11-13)**. Kfb. K2. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. **24 (30-34)** sts.

Sizes 8/10 and Adult only: **5th rnd:** K(**11-13**). Kfb. K4. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. (**32-36**) sts. **6th rnd:** Knit.

Size Adult only: 7th rnd: K13. Kfb. K6. Kfb. Knit to end of rnd. 38 sts. **8th rnd:** Knit.

All sizes: Next rnd: K**14 (19-23)**. Slip last **6 (8-10)** sts onto safety pin (thumb opening). Knit to end of rnd. Break D.

Next rnd: With B, knit, casting on 2 sts over slipped sts. **20 (26-30)** sts.

Work from *** to *** as given for Right Mitten, substituting B for D, A for E and C for B.
