## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\oplus}$ (Solids: 6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m; Paints: $4 \mathrm{oz} / 113.4$ g; 204 yds/186 m)

| Contrast A Sunset (P0008) | $\mathbf{1}$ | ball |

| Contrast B Chocolate (39750) | $\mathbf{1}$ | ball |

Sizes U.S. 7 ( 4.5 mm ) and U.S. $8(5 \mathrm{~mm})$ knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## SIZES

One size to average Woman.

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needles and $A$, cast on 98 sts. Work in garter st (knit every row), noting 1st row is WS, until Hat measures $41 / 2$ " [11.5 cm], ending on a WS row. Break A.

Change to larger needles, $B$ and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures $51 / 2 "[14 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending on a purl row.

Shape top: 1 st row: (RS). K1. *K9. ssk. K2. K2tog. K9. Rep from * to last st. K1. 90 sts. 2nd and alt rows: Purl.
3rd row: K1. *K8. ssk. K2. K2tog. K8. Rep from * to last st. K1. 82 sts.
5th row: K1. *K7. ssk. K2. K2tog. K7. Rep from * to last st. K1. 74 sts.
7th row: K1. *K6. ssk. K2. K2tog. K6. Rep from * to last st. K1. 66 sts. 9th row: K1. *K5. ssk. K2. K2tog. K5. Rep from * to last st. K1. 58 sts.
11th row: K1. *K4. ssk. K2. K2tog. K4. Rep from * to last st. K1. 50 sts.

13th row: K1. *K3. ssk. K2. K2tog. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1. 42 sts.
15th row: K1. *K2. ssk. K2. K2tog. K2. Rep from * to last st. K1. 34 sts.
17th row: K1. *K1. ssk. K2. K2tog. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1. 26 sts.
19th row: K1. *ssk. K2. K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. 18 sts.
Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end through remaining (rem) sts tightly and fasten securely. Sew back seam.
