KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## AbBreviations

Alt $=$ Alternate
Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Begin(ning)
Dec $=$ Decrease
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
$\mathbf{K} 1$ below = Knit into next stitch
1 row below at same time slipping
off stitch above

$\mathbf{K 1 t b l}=$ Knit next stitch through back of loop

## SIZE

One size to fit adult.

## GAUGE

12 sts and 30 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Shaker Rib Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: When working K1below after a dec row, be sure to insert the right-handed needle into all loops of decrease worked in previous row.

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Chunky Cupcakes ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ (3.5 oz/100 g; $138 \mathrm{yds} / 126 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Jelly Bean (23001)
1 ball
Size U.S. 9 ( 5.5 mm ) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

K2 $\mathbf{t o g}=$ Knit 2 stitches together Psso = Pass slipped stitch over P = Purl
P1tbl = Purl next stitch through
back of loop
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
SI1 = Slip next stitch knit-wise
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS $=$ Wrong side

Cast on 71 sts.
1st row: (RS). K1. K1tbl. *P1tbl. K1tbl. Rep from * to last st. K1.
2nd row: P1. P1tbl. *K1tbl. P1tbl. Rep from * to last st. P1.
Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures approx $11 / 2$ " [ 4 cm ], ending on a RS row.

Proceed in Shaker Rib Pat:
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: K1. K1below. *P1. K1below. Rep from * to last st. K1. Rep last 2 rows for Shaker Rib Pat until work from beg measures 7 " $[18 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a RS row.

## CROC SHAKER RIB KNIT HAT | KNIT

Shape top: 1st row: (WS). K1. *SI1. K2tog. psso. K3. Rep from * to last 4 sts. SI1. K2tog. psso. K1. 47 sts.
2nd and alt rows: K1. K1below. *P1. K1below. Rep from * to last st. K1.
3rd row: Knit.
5th row: Knit.
7th row: K1. *SI1. K2tog. psso. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. 25 sts. 9th row: Knit.
11th row: Knit.
13th row: *K2tog. Rep from * to last st. K1. 13 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam. Sew pompom to top of Hat.
