#### **MATERIALS**

**Caron® x Pantone™** (3.5 oz /100 g;127 yds/116 m)

Sunset Streak (01042)

braid

Set of 4 sizes U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) and U.S. 10 (6 mm) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

# KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Alt** = Alternate

**Beg** = Begin(ning)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches

together

 $\mathbf{P} = Purl$ 

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**Rep** = Repeat

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## **SIZE**

One size to fit adult.


# **GAUGE**

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking stitch.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

### **Notes:**

• Before working with Caron x Pantone multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.









# **CARON** GRAPHIC KNIT FAIR ISLE HAT

- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone color # (see label)
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results
- When working from charts, carry yarn not in use loosely across WS of work. The colors are never twisted around one another.

#### **HAT**

With A and set of smaller double-pointed needles, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts evenly over 3 needles (24-24-24). Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

**1st to 11th rnds:** \*K3. P1. Rep from \* around. Break A.

Change to larger set of needles.

Next 3 rnds: With A, K1. \*With B, K1. With A, K3. Rep from \* to last 3 sts. With B, K1. With A, K2.

Knit rnds 1 to 25 of Chart, reading rows from right to left, noting 4-st rep will be worked 18 times.

**Shape top: 1st rnd:** With E, \*K7. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 64 sts.

**2nd and 3rd rnds:** \*With E, K3. With B, K1. Rep from \* around.

**4th rnd:** \*With D, K1. With B, K1. Rep from \* around.

**5th and 6th rnds:** \*With D, K1. With B, K1. With D, K2. Rep from \* around.

**7th rnd:** With D, \*K6. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 56 sts.

**8th and 9th rnds:** \*With D, K3. With E, K1. Rep from \* around.

**10th rnd:** \*With C, K1. With E, K1. Rep from \* around.

**11th and 12th rnds:** \*With C, K1. With E, K1. With C, K2. Rep from \* around.

**13th rnd:** With C, \*K5. K2tog. Rep from \* around, 48 sts.

14th rnd: With C, knit.

**15th rnd:** With C, \*K4. K2tog. Rep

from \* around. 40 sts.

**16th rnd:** With D, \*K3. K2tog. Rep


from \* around. 32 sts.

**17th rnd:** With D, \*K2. K2tog. Rep


from \* around. 24 sts.

**18th rnd:** With D, \*K1. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 16 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts and draw up tightly. Fasten securely. **Pompom:** Wind B and E around 4 fingers until all yarn is used. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Sew to top of Hat.
