MATERIALS

Caron [®] Simply Soft [®] (Solids: 6 oz/170 g;	315	yds/288	m;
Heathers: 5 oz/141.7 g; 250 yds/228 m)			
Contrast A Gray Heather (H9509)	1	ball	
Contrast B Lt Country Peach (9737)	1	ball	
Contrast C Woodland Heather (H9503)	1	ball	
Contrast D Off White (9702)	1	ball	
Contrast E Lt Country Blue (9709)	1	ball	
Contrast F Country Blue (9710)	1	ball	
Contrast G Dk Country Blue (9711)	1	ball	

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 16" [40 cm] long. Set of four size U.S. 8 (5 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

<u>SIZE</u>

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

Work 2 rows of each color: A, B, C, D, E, F, B, G. These 16 rows form Stripe Pat.

HAT

With A and circular needle, cast on 88 sts. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around. First 2 rnds of Stripe Pat are complete (cast on edge counts as 1 rnd). Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing 10 times more.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, knit in rnds until work from beg measures 7¹/₂" [19 cm], ending with 2 rnds of any color.

Note: Move to double-pointed needles for top shaping.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows: **Shape crown: 1st rnd:** *K6. K2tog. Rep from * around. 77 sts.

2nd and alt rnds: Knit.

3rd rnd: *K5. K2tog. Rep from * around. 66 sts.

5th rnd: *K4. K2tog. Rep from * around. 55 sts.



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7th rnd: *K3. K2tog. Rep from * around. 44 sts. 9th rnds: *K2. K2tog. Rep from * around. 33 sts. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through rem sts. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

Pompom: Wind A around 3 fingers 100 times. Tie tightly in the middle and leave a long end for attaching to Hat. Cut loops at both ends and trim to smooth round shape. Sew securely to top of Hat.
