SIZING

Add a jolt of pizzazz to your fall wardrobe with this fashion-forward scarf in a blackberry stitch.

Abbreviations

P3tog = Pass slipped stitch over

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

Details & Instructions

MEASUREMENTS

Finished measurement

Scarf measures 6 ½"/16.5cm wide x 50"/127cm long

MATERIALS

Scarf

Simply Soft (170 g/6. oz;288 m/315 yds)



Contrast A Black (9727)

1

One pair size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) needles or size to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

Simply Soft Party (85 g/3. oz;150 m/164 yds)



GAUGE

In Blackberry stitch, 24 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10 cm.

INSTRUCTIONS

PATTERN STITCH

Blackberry Stitch (multiple of 4 sts):

Rows 1 and 2: Purl. Row 3 (RS): Purl.

Row 4: *(K1, p1, k1) in next st, p3 tog; rep from * across.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: *P3 tog, (k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * across.

Rep Rows 3-6 for Blackberry st.

SCARF

With A, CO 36 sts. Rows 1 and 2: Purl.

Rows 3 (RS): With A, purl.

Row 4: With B, p2, *(k1, p1, k1) in next st, p3 tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 5: With B, purl.

Row 6: With A, p2, *p3 tog, (k1, p1, k1) in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Rep Rows 3-6 keeping first 2 and last 2 sts in p every row until scarf measures approximately $49 \frac{1}{2}$ " from CO edge, ending with patt Row 3.

With A, purl 2 more rows.

BO all sts in knit.

FINISHING

Block scarf if needed.

Using yarn needle, weave in any loose ends.
