Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Tea Cakes ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $8.5 \mathrm{oz} / 240 \mathrm{~g} ; 204 \mathrm{yds} / 186 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Ginger Spice (20002)

## 3 balls

Size U.S. 11 ( 8 mm ) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 12" x 84" [30.5 x 213 cm ], excluding fringe

## GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in Linen St Pat

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: For striping effect shown, work with 2 cakes throughout. Begin using each cake at different points in color transition to ensure contrasting colors. In most cases, this is achieved by working from the exterior of first cake and from interior of second.

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over
Rem = Remaining
Rep $=$ Repeat
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
SI1 = Slip next stitch knitwise
St(s) = Stitch(es)
SI1wyib = Slip next stitch with
yarn in back
SI1wyif = Slip next stitch with
yarn in front
Tog = Together

If necessary to ensure color contrast, remove a single color from exterior of one cake then set this yarn aside to be used as fringe. Alternate between these 2 cakes every 2 rows.

Cast on 46 sts.
1st row: *K1. SI1wyif. Rep from * across.
2nd row: *P1. Sl1wyib. Rep from * across.

Keeping continuing the striping effect (see note above), rep these 2 rows for Linen Stitch Pat until Scarf measures approx 84"

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## CROD LINEN STITCH KNIT SCARF | KNIT

[213 cm] from beg, ending on 2nd row. Cast off.

Fringe: Cut lengths of yarn 20" [51 cm ] long. Taking 4 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe evenly across each end of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
