ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate
Approx = Approximate(ly)
Cont = Continue(ity)
K = Knit
RS = Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)

W&T = Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.

MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Spicy Blooms (01014) **2 braids**
 Blueberry (01009) **2 braids**

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" [23 cm] wide x 60" [152.5 cm] long.

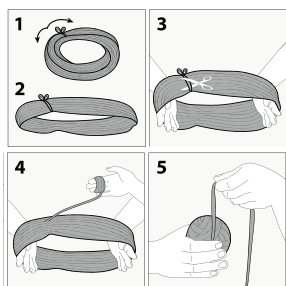
GAUGE

15 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Before working with Caron x Pantone multi-shade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone™ color # (see label).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.

FIRST TRIANGLE

With Color 1 (as indicated in chart on page 1), cast on 34 sts.

****1st row:** (RS). Knit.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: K32. W&T.

4th and alt rows: Knit.

5th row: K30. W&T.

7th row: K28. W&T.

9th row: K26. W&T.

11th row: K24. W&T.

13th row: K22. W&T.

15th row: K20. W&T.

17th row: K18. W&T.

19th row: K16. W&T.

21st row: K14. W&T.

23rd row: K12. W&T.

25th row: K10. W&T.

27th row: K8. W&T.

29th row: K6. W&T.

31st row: K4. W&T.

33rd row: K2. W&T.

35th row: Knit (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).

36th row: Knit.**

Break Color 1. Join Color 2 (as indicated in chart).

SECOND TRIANGLE

*****1st row:** (RS). With Color 2, knit.

2nd row: K32. W&T.

3rd and alt rows: Knit.

4th row: K30. W&T.

6th row: K28. W&T.

8th row: K26. W&T.

10th row: K24. W&T.

12th row: K22. W&T.

14th row: K20. W&T.

16th row: K18. W&T.

18th row: K16. W&T.

20th row: K14. W&T.

22nd row: K12. W&T.

24th row: K10. W&T.

26th row: K8. W&T.

28th row: K6. W&T.

30th row: K4. W&T.

32nd row: K2. W&T.

33rd row: Knit.

34th row: Knit (you do not have to pick up and knit the wraps, just knit as you normally would).***

Break Color 2. Join Color 3 (as indicated in chart).

THIRD TRIANGLE

With Color 3, work from ** to ** as given for First Triangle.

Break Color 3. Join Color 4 (as indicated in chart).

FOURTH TRIANGLE

With Color 4, work from *** to *** as given for Second Triangle.

Break Color 4. Join Color 5 (as indicated in chart).

Cont as established, following Chart for color changes until 20 Triangles have been worked.

With Color 20, cast off.
