



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Center dec = Slip next 2 sts together knitwise. Knit next st, then pass both slipped sts over knit st.

Cont = Continue

K = Knit

Pat = Pattern

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 12" wide x 96" long [30.5 cm wide x 244 cm long] not including fringe.

GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With Color 1: 32 rows.

With Color 2: 32 rows.

With Color 3: 32 rows.

These 96 rows form Stripe Pat.

Square

Make 1 with Color 1 as A, Color 2 as B, and Color 3 as C.

Make 1 with Color 1 as D, Color 2 as E, and Color 3 as F.

Make 1 with Color 1 as E, Color 2 as A, and Color 3 as D.

Make 1 with Color 1 as F, Color 2 as C, and Color 3 as B.

Make 1 with Color 1 as E, Color 2 as D, and Color 3 as A.

Make 1 with Color 1 as C, Color 2 as F, and Color 3 as B.

Make 1 with Color 1 as D, Color 2 as E, and Color 3 as B.

Make 1 with Color 1 as A, Color 2 as F, and Color 3 as C.

With Color 1, cast on 97 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K47. Center dec. K47.

3rd and alt rows: Knit.

4th row: K46. Center dec. K46.

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft™ (Solids: 6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m; Heathers: 5 oz/141 g; 250 yds/228 m)

Contrast A Burgundy (9762) **1 ball**

Contrast B Persimmon (9754) **1 ball**

Contrast C Harvest Red (9763) **1 ball**

Contrast D Gray Heather (H9509) **1 ball**

Contrast E Pumpkin (9765) **1 ball**

Contrast F Off White (9702) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 24" [61 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

6th row: K45. Center dec. K45.

First 6 rows of Stripe Pat complete. Cont in pat as established until 95 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed.

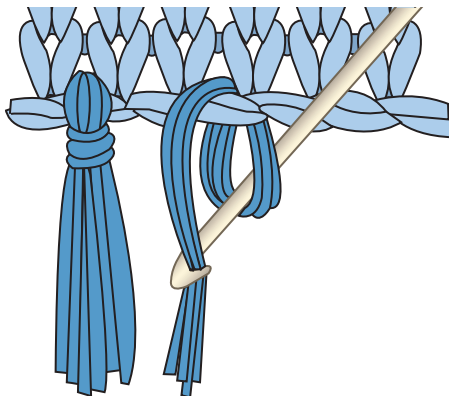
Next row: Center dec.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew Squares as shown in diagram.

Fringe: With C and E, cut lengths of yarn 24" [61 cm] long. Taking 4 strands of same shade tog, and alternating between C and E, fold in half and knot into fringe along both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
