



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Center dec** = (worked over 3 sts)

Slip next 2 stitches as if to K2tog.

K1, then pass slipped sts over knit

st – center of 3 stitches should

be on top of decrease. 2 stitches

have been decreased

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches

together

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pattern

**PM** = Place marker

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**SI1P** = Slip next stitch purlwise.

**Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise

one at a time. Pass them back

onto left-hand needle, then knit

through back loops together

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## SIZES

**Hat:** One size to fit Adult.

**Scarf:** Approx 7½" x 65" [19 x 165 cm]

## GAUGE

**Hat:** 20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with U.S. 6 [4 mm] needles.

**Scarf:** 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with U.S. 8 [5 mm] needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### HAT

#### Hat Stripe Pat

With A, work 15 rnds.

With B, work 15 rnds.

With C, work 15 rnds.

With D, work 15 rnds.

These 60 rnds form Hat Stripe Pat.

## MATERIALS

**Caron® Simply Soft™** (6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

**Contrast A** Lavender Blue (39756) **1 ball**

**Contrast B** Off White (39702) **1 ball**

**Contrast C** Persimmon (39754) **1 ball**

**Contrast D** Black (39727) **1 ball**

**Contrast E** Taupe (39783) **1 ball**

**Hat:** Size U.S. 6 [4 mm] circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long. Set of 4 size U.S. 6 [4 mm] double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

**Scarf:** Size U.S. 8 [5 mm] knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

With circular needle and A, cast on 96 sts. PM and join to work in rnd, being careful not to twist.

**1st rnd:** \*K1. P1. Rep from\* around.

1st rnd of Stripe Pat is now complete. Rep last rnd of (K1. P1) ribbing until all 60 rnds of Hat Stripe Pat are complete. Break D. Join E.

### Shape Crown:

**Note:** Work rem rnds with E only. Change to double-pointed needles when necessary.

**1st rnd:** \*(K1. P1) twice. ssk. K1. K2tog. P1. K1. P1. Rep from \* around. 80 sts.

**2nd to 5th rnds:** \*(K1. P1) twice. K3. P1. K1. P1. Rep from \* around.

**6th rnd:** \*(K1. P1) twice. Center Dec. P1. K1. P1. Rep from \* around. 64 sts.

**7th to 10th rnds:** \*K1. P1. Rep from \* around.

**11th rnd:** \*K1. P1. ssk. K1. K2tog. P1. Rep from \* around. 48 sts.

**12th and 13th rnds:** \*K1. P1. K3. P1. Rep from \* around.

**14th rnd:** \*K1. P1. Center dec. P1. Rep from \* around. 32 sts.

**15th and 16th rnds:** \*K1. P1. Rep from \* around.

**17th rnd:** \*ssk. K2tog. Rep from \* around. 16 sts.

**18th rnd:** \*K2tog. Rep from \* around. 8 sts.

Break yarn, leaving a long end. Draw end through rem sts and fasten securely.

### SCARF

#### Scarf Stripe Pat

With A, work 12 rows.

With B, work 12 rows.

With C, work 12 rows.

With D, work 12 rows.

With E, work 12 rows.

These 60 rows form Scarf Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 41 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row:** Sl1P. \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Sl1P. \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

First 3 rows of Scarf Stripe Pat are now complete.

Rep last 2 rows of (K1. P1) ribbing and cont in Scarf Stripe Pat until work from beg measures approx 65" [165 cm], ending with any complete 12-row stripe of Scarf Stripe Pat.

Cast off knitwise with same shade as final stripe.
