ASYMMETRICAL KNIT SHAWL | KNIT



MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Version 1 or Version 2

Morning Blues (01016) 4 braids

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Center Dec = (worked over 3 sts)
Slip next 2 stitches as if to K2tog.
K1, then pass slipped sts over knit
st – center of 3 sts should be on
top of decrease, 2 sts have been
decreased

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of

work

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 29" [73.5 cm] deep x 62"[157.5 cm] long.

GAUGE

14 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multishade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid



 Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone[™] color # (see label).



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- Designate each yarn ball Contrast, A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results

Stripe Pat Version 1

With A, knit 62 rows. With B, knit 28 rows. With C, knit 22 rows.

With D, knit 26 rows.

With E, knit 24 rows.

With A, knit 12 rows.

With B, knit 8 rows.

With C, knit 10 rows.

With C, Kill TO TOWS

With D, knit 2 rows.

These 194 rows form Stripe Pat.

Version 2

With E, knit 44 rows. With A, knit 2 rows. With D, knit 18 rows. With A, knit 2 rows.

With C, knit 14 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With B, knit 14 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With E, knit 10 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With D, knit 10 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With C, knit 10 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With B, knit 16 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With E, knit 8 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With D, knit 10 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With C, knit 14 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With B, knit 4 rows.

These 194 rows form Stripe Pat.

Both Versions:

Note: Move marker up each row on marked st.

With A for Version 1 or E for Version 2, cast on 1 st.

1st row: (RS). (K1. yo. K1) all in stitch. 3 sts.

2nd row: K1. P1. K1.

3rd row: Kfb. K1. Kfb. 5 sts.

4th row: Kfb. K1. SI1Pwyif. Kfb. K1.

7 sts.

5th row: Kfb. K1. Center dec. PM

on last st. Kfb. K1. 7 sts.

6th row: K3. SI1Pwyif (marked st).

K3.

7th row: Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.

8 sts.

8th row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. Sl1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 10 sts.

9th row: Kfb. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. 10 sts.

10th row: Knit to marked st. SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.

First 10 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 7th to 10th rows until there are 124 sts, ending on 10th row.

Next row: (RS). K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1.


Next row: Kfb. Knit to marked st. Sl1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. Next row: K2tog. Knit to 1 st before marked st. Center dec. PM on last st. Knit to last 2 sts. Kfb. K1. **Next row:** Knit to marked st. Sl1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. Rep last 4 rows, keeping cont of Stripe Pat, until Stripe Pat is

complete. Cast off.





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
