ZIG-ZAG MITERED KNIT SHAWL | KNIT



MATERIALS

Caron® **x Pantone**™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m) Main Color (MC) Dane Gray (01003) 1 braid **Contrast** Moody Pumpkins (01021) 7 braids

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternat(e)(ing)

Approx = Approximately

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dec = Decreas(e)(ing)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches

together

PM = Place marker

Psso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

SI1 = Slip next stitch knitwise **Sl1Pwyif** = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of work.

SM = Slip marker

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 20" x 78" [51 x 198 cm].

GAUGE

14 sts and 28 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

Before working with Caron yarn multi-shade braid. separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



Each color link will referenced by its Pantone # (see label).



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- Designate different each shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted in Materials section (or as desired).
- Due to finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results

With A, cast on 244 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Block One

See diagram on page 3. **1st row: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: K12. K2tog. PM. ssk. Knit

to end of row, 242 sts.

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. SM. ssk. Knit to end of row.

5th row: Knit.

Rep 4th and 5th rows 5 times more.** Break A. Join B.

***Rep 4th and 5th rows 6 times more.

Next row: Sl1. K2tog. psso. Knit to

end of row.

Next row: Knit.***

Break B.

Block Two

With C, cast 14 sts onto right-hand needle. With RS facing, join to rem sts on left-hand needle. Knit to end of row. 230 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Block One.

Break C. Join D.

Work from *** to *** as given for Block One. Break D.

Block Three

With E, cast 14 sts onto right-hand needle. With RS facing, join to rem sts on left-hand needle. Knit to end of row. 216 sts.

Work from ** to ** as given for Block One.

Break E. Join A.

Work from *** to *** as given for Block One.

Break A.

Block Four

With B, cast 14 sts onto right-hand needle. With RS facing, join to rem sts on left-hand needle. Knit to end of row, 202 sts.

Block One.

Break B. Join C.

Work from *** to *** as given for rem, ending on a WS row. Block One.

Break C.

Block Five

With D, cast 14 sts onto right-hand needle. With RS facing, join to rem sts on left-hand needle. Knit to end of row. 188 sts.

Block One.

Break D. Join E.

Work from *** to *** as given for **5th row:** Sl1Pwyif. K2tog. K15. Sl1. Block One.

Cast off knitwise.

Border

Section One

With MC, cast on 21 sts.

1st and alt rows: (WS). Knit.

2nd row: SI1Pwyif. K2tog. K17. SI1. Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of

Block One. psso. 20 sts.

4th row: SI1Pwyif. K2tog. K16. SI1. Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of Block One. psso. 19 sts.

6th row: SI1Pwyif. K2tog. K15. SI1. Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of Block One. psso. 18 sts.

7th row: Knit.

Work from ** to ** as given for Cont as established, dec 1 st each RS row, until entire height of Block One has been worked up and 7 sts

Section Two

1st row: (RS). SI1Pwyif. K2tog. K4. Pick up and knit 13 sts along top of Block One. Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of Block Two. 20 sts.

2nd row: Knit

3rd row: SI1Pwyif. K2tog. K16. SI1. Work from ** to ** as given for Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of Block One. psso. 19 sts.

4th row: Knit.

Pick up and knit 1 st along edge of Block One. psso. 18 sts.

Cont as established, dec 1 st each RS row, until entire height of Block Two has been worked up and 7 sts rem, ending on a WS row.

Sections Three to Five

cast off rem 7 sts.

Cont as established, working along tops of Blocks Two to Four, and up edges of Blocks Three to Five. When Section Five is complete,



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
